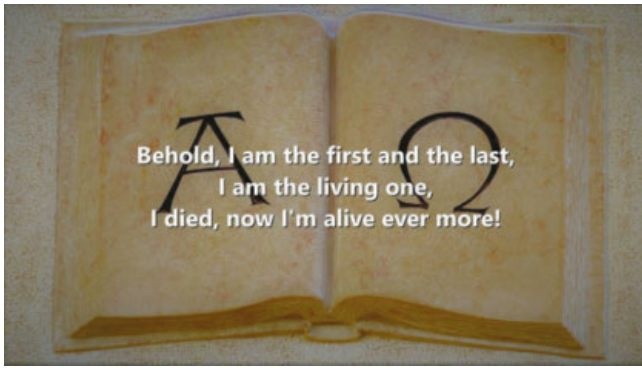

"I am the first and the last, the one who lives.

Do not be unbelieving, but believe. (John 20:27).

Everyone had heard about the man who lived among the tombs, unable to be restrained (Mark 5:1-18). Surely people warned Jesus to stay away from him. Yet he continued on, filled with compassion. As they met, the man was so tormented he couldn't even ask for help. But Jesus spoke, the demons fled, and the man was released. Divine mercy brings freedom.

As Jesus was leaving Jericho, two blind men called out to him: "Son of David, have pity on us!" (Matthew 20:29-30). People told them to be quiet, but they shouted all the louder. They knew how much they needed him. Again, full of love, Jesus touched their eyes and restored their sight. Divine mercy brings healing.

Zacchaeus was a tax collector known for extorting money. Yet when he heard Jesus would be coming by, he was determined to see him (Luke 19:1-10). He was not deterred by his short stature but climbed a tree to get a good view. Jesus called to him, and the two shared a meal together. Divine mercy transforms lives.

This is the miracle of divine mercy: It is available to all of us right now. It is a free and boundless gift from our Father. He has prepared a banquet hall for us, and he invites us all to come. With bold and eager hearts, not allowing unbelief to keep us away, we can enter in and receive all that he has for us.

God's mercy is a fresh, ever-rushing river. Jesus is inviting you today to immerse yourself in his cleansing tide. How great is the love that God lavishes on his children! His mercy is not earned but is given freely. So don't hesitate. Come and surrender to him, and receive the freedom, healing, and transformation that spring from the heart of Christ!

Saint Faustina: Mankind’s need for the message of Divine Mercy took on dire urgency in the 20th Century, when civilization began to experience an “eclipse of the sense of God” and, therefore to lose the understanding of the sanctity and inherent dignity of human life. In the 1930s, Jesus chose a humble Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive private revelations concerning Divine Mercy that were recorded in her Diary.

Divine Mercy Sunday: St. Faustina’s Diary records 14 occasions when Jesus requested that a Feast of Mercy (Divine Mercy Sunday) be observed, for example: My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me. ... It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter.

Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy. —St. Faustina, *Diary*, no. 699. On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Image: Jesus appeared to St. Faustina in a vision, with his right hand raised in a blessing and his left touching his garment above his heart. Red and white rays emanate from his heart, symbolizing the blood and water that was poured out for our salvation and our sanctification. The Lord requested that “Jesus, I trust in You” be inscribed under his image. Jesus asked that his image be painted and venerated throughout the world: “I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish” (Diary, no. 48) and “By means of this image I will grant many graces to souls” (Diary, no. 742).

Did you know...The Catholic Church is deeply committed to protecting children from abuse and holding people accountable for inflicting such pain. In December 2021, the revised Book VI of the Code of Canon Law went into effect. This is the most recent of several documents that specifically address the issue of the abuse of children. Other documents include *Vos estis lux mundi* and *Vademecum*. These documents expand the acts which are considered abusive, clarify the manner in which the cases are processed, and hold people accountable for their action or inaction with regard to processing of a case. Of significant importance is attention given to the care of victim survivors and all who have been harmed.

Bishops in the US lead the way for these changes with the implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People 20 years ago. Today every diocese and eparchy must have in place systems for tending to those who have been harmed, protecting those in our care and seeking restorative justice.

What Happens After Easter?



Earth convulsed with a strong earthquake on Good Friday. The sun was darkened. Jerusalem was in shock. His disciples were in mourning, cringing in secret for fear of the authorities. A Jewish priest witnessed the 30-foot temple veil, separating the Holy Place from the Holy of Holies, tear in half from top to bottom. What did that catastrophe mean?

Then, it's Sunday morning. Not just the first day of a new week. It was the first day of the New Covenant. The angel in the tomb, where Jesus had lain dead, told the women who came to anoint his body, "*He is not here, he is risen.*" His resurrection is our resurrection – first the spiritual one by faith and baptism; then the physical one when he returns. We're in a post resurrection age.

The curtain (veil) through which only the High Priest could enter into the presence of God, once per year on the Day of Atonement, was torn in half. The curtain represents the torn body of Jesus. Through his body we enter God's throne room. Hebrews 10:14: "*For by one offering he (Jesus) has made perfect forever those who are being consecrated.*" Chapter 4:16 reads: "*So, let us confidently approach the throne of grace to receive mercy and to find grace for timely help.*"

"*Made perfect forever*" is past tense. "*Are being consecrated*" is present continuous tense. The past tense is our adoption as sons and daughters - a done deal. But until we join him in heaven, he will continue to bring our natural life (our behavior) into harmony with our standing.

How does that happen? By how we live. Matthew 4:4: "*One does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.*" Easter is past. We are perfect. Scripture helps us act like it. Peace be with you!

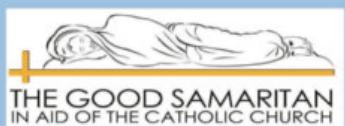

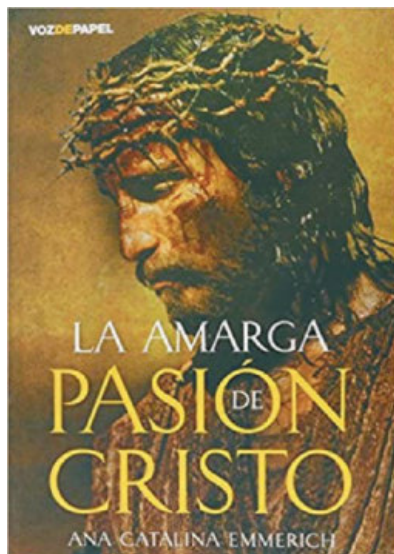

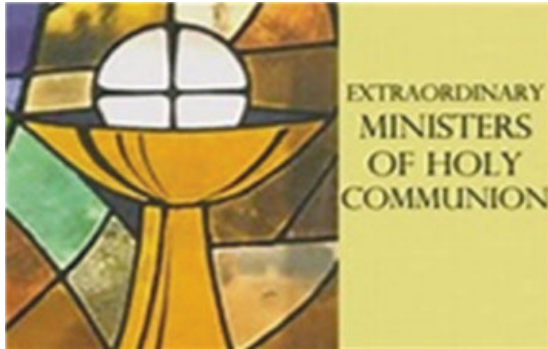
