

Jesus came over and took the bread and gave it to them, and in like manner the fish.

(Jn 21:13)

Do you love me? (John 21:15).

Jesus' questioning of Peter in such a direct way was not intended to make Peter feel guilty. And neither was it an ego trip for the Lord. Jesus didn't need Peter's love to feel better about himself. He already knew-better than Peter himself - how much Peter loved him. Rather, Jesus wanted Peter to reach deep within himself and see how much love for the Lord was actually there.

Jesus questioned Peter at a pivotal moment to show that Peter's love for him was greater than any opposing power that might try to keep him bound in the memory of his failures. He wanted Peter to see that while he would make mistakes, his love for Jesus could still cover a multitude of human failings. This was probably one of the most encouraging interrogations anyone could experience! True, Jesus' questions must have disturbed Peter. But in the end, they actually restored his faith in himself as a child of God and as a chosen apostle. They helped Peter understand that even in spite of his imperfections, he could still serve Jesus fully.


Today, Jesus asks each of us, "Do you love me?" even though he already knows the answer. We should welcome this kind of questioning. He doesn't doubt us. He only wants to burn away any unbelief in us with the fire of his love - a love that will create an even deeper love for him in our hearts.

Today at Mass, welcome Jesus into your heart so that he can expand your capacity to love. Yes, you will make mistakes; no one is sinless. But know that as you declare your love to Jesus, he will strengthen you and empower you to take up the work he has called you to. Then your love for him will become the visible proof that his kingdom really has come to earth.

"Jesus, you know how much I love you. Continue refining me with the fire of your love so that I may love you more and show my love to you and my neighbors."

Faithful or Fainting? At Your Limit?



In Luke 18:1, he writes: "Then He (Jesus) told them a parable about the need to pray continually and never lose heart." Failing to pray and losing heart in a crisis correlate. Likewise, prayer and faithful-

ness correlate. It's prayer or panic.

Not many issues take us to our limit. Does that minimize the need for prayer? Luke says the parable is about praying *continually*. Continual prayer prevents losing heart. Staying 'prayed up' is the point. "Give us *this day* our daily bread." We need bread every day; we ask for it every day, along with everything else we and others need.

If our faith grows through trials, should we hope to avoid trials or lose heart during them? Of course, neither. Pleasant times are great, but they don't stretch our faith. When Jesus said in the Beatitudes, 'Blessed are the poor in spirit,' and 'Blessed are they that mourn,' he was talking about the outcomes St. Paul listed in Galations 5:22: "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control." People with that fruit in their lives have reached their limit many times, but got through it - not around it - by prayer and enduring faith.

Jesus invited Peter to walk on the water toward him in the middle of a raging storm (Matthew 14:30): "But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and beginning to sink he cried out, "Lord, save me." When we doubt, we go down. Of course, Jesus saved him. He wants all of us to step out in faith and he will save us when we reach our limit. Your prayer will save you too in a crisis but don't wait until then to start praying.

If you are a praying man, join your prayers with ours in the Knights of Columbus. Together, we bring the fruit of the Spirit to our Parish and beyond.
