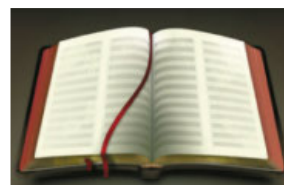

The Most Holy Trinity

June 12, 2022

*The love of God has been poured out
into our hearts through the Holy Spirit
that has been given to us.*

(Rom 5:5)

When we come to worship, we usually make the sign of the cross. The words that accompany this holy action, 'In the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit,' remind us that there are three persons in God. The feast of the Holy Trinity is a celebration of the mystery of God as a family of love. We have not been left in the dark in our struggle to attempt to understand God. From what Jesus said and did while on earth, we can grasp little pieces of the innermost being of the mystery of God. Throughout his life, Jesus was forever talking about God as his Father, and he referred to himself as God's only Son. He explained also that his mission was to do the will of the Father. Jesus introduces us to the Spirit whom he talks about as being a real person, completely different from himself and God the Father. The Spirit's job is to inspire people to continue in the church the work begun by Jesus and draw everyone into the love of God the Father.

This feast reminds us of a simple truth which we often forget God's plan is that we share in his life of glory. By our baptism we are raised to a level at which we become sharers in the family life of God. We are born of God the Father, God the Son becomes our brother and the love of God is poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit. This revelation of his inner life of three persons, in which we have a share, is one of God's greatest gifts to us and it is the model towards which all of us should aim and strive.

Jesus reveals the mystery of the Trinity to us, not just to let us know the truth about God, but also to know the truth about ourselves as to what is our origin, where is our destiny and how we can arrive at that final point. We only exist, and the world only exists, because God gives life. He is the Father who looks upon us as his children and is closer to us than we are to ourselves. Everyday is a day to love the Father, Son and Holy Spirit so we should strive to make the Holy Trinity a more practical part of our lives. Love is the binding force of the three persons of the Trinity; so when we love we share in that community of love which is the living God.

This celebration of the abundance of God's love is an occasion for appreciating what God has done and continues to do for us. It calls on us to respond to the love of God, poured into our hearts by Christ and the Holy Spirit, and invites us to look forward to the day when we shall share in the glory of God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

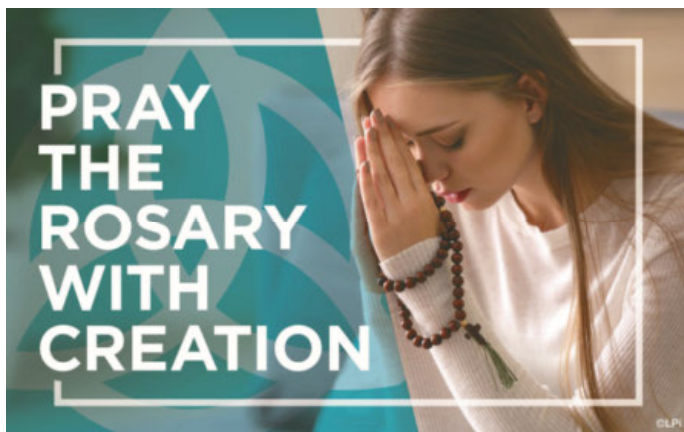

Questions for God

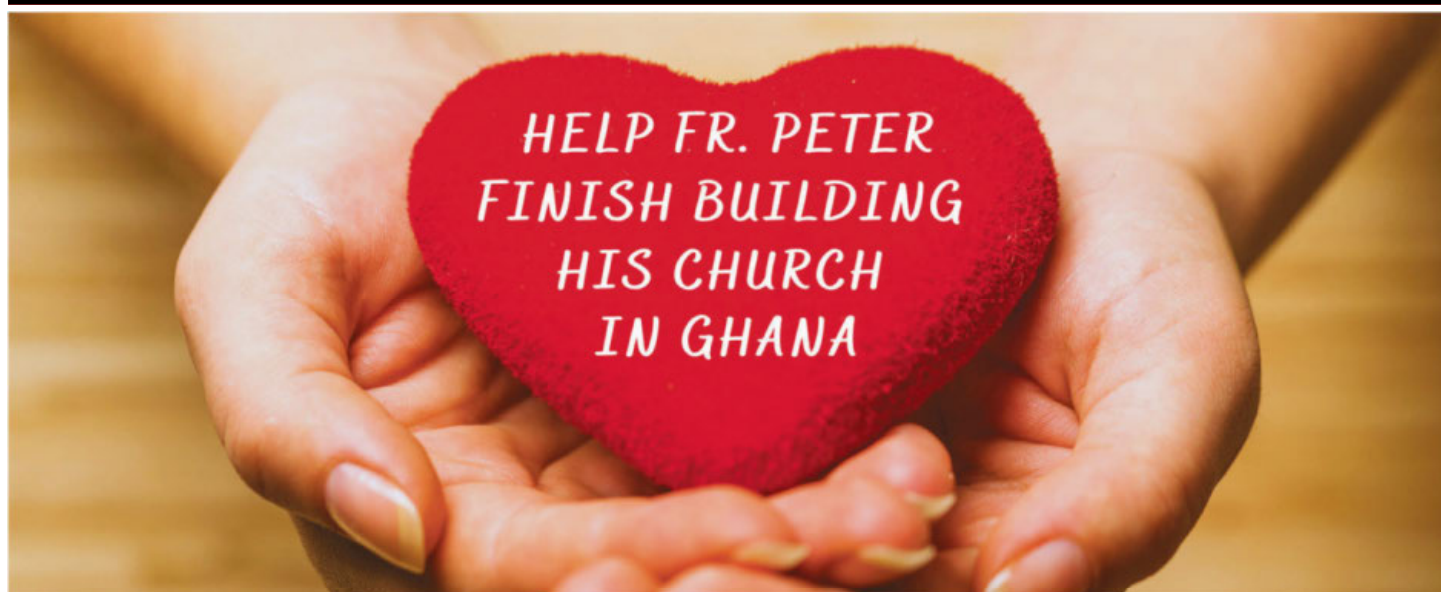

From the author, Peggy Olds: "Our children come from God and it is our responsibility to see that they return to him. Good religious education begins at birth. Reading Questions for God to/with your child and making nightly prayers a priority will go far in laying a strong, Catholic foundation.

As parents, we realize how inquisitive our children are about life, but we tend to ignore this quality when it comes to our Faith. Our little ones are eager to learn how everything began and is sustained. They are able to understand and absorb so much more than we realize. It is our responsibility to capitalize on the eagerness of the little ones and teach them their spiritual heritage. It is never too early to begin.

It is my belief that we are amply addressing the "reading, writing and arithmetic" aspects of the child's early development, however, the spiritual aspect of a child's development has been generally overlooked. If a child can learn the vocabulary of the English language, the child can learn the vocabulary of the Church. If a child can learn the ABC's, a child can learn the basic prayers of the Church. If a child is to believe that God loves him/her and he/she should love Him back, a child needs to know Who and what God is. It is our responsibility to begin teaching the truths of our faith as early as we begin teaching the ABC's.

Fr. Ignatius John Schweitzer, O.P. is a Dominican priest of the St. Joseph (Eastern) Province. He was ordained in 2011. He spent six years living as a monk in a Carthusian monastery. He then returned to the Dominicans, discerning a strong call from the Lord to help others grow in the spiritual and mystical life. He is the prior of St. Catherine of Siena Priory in New York City.



Fr. Jesse Maingot O.P. is a Dominican priest of the Irish Province. He was ordained in 2019. He was chaplain to Dominican College, Newbridge, Ireland where he ministered to hundreds of young people. Across Ireland he was frequently asked to preach talks and retreat days. Fr. Jesse is currently studying for an STL in Dogmatic Theology at the Angelicum University in Rome.



Dr. Thomas Carr, O.P. received his Master of Divinity from Princeton Theological Seminary and his Master and Doctorate in Philosophy & Theology from the University of Oxford. A convert to Catholicism and a Lay Dominican, Dr. Carr served as Professor of Philosophy and Religious Studies at the University of Mount Union for seventeen years.



Mrs. Ina Carr, O.P. is a mother of two, a Lay Dominican, and a convert to Catholicism. She has a Master in Leadership and Management and a Graduate Diploma in Christian Studies. She has many years of experience in various ministries, e.g., serving the poor in a post-conflict area; in a nursing home; in inner city, prison, prayer and deliverance ministries; and as a church planter.

Prayer is the life of the soul. It is our contact with the living God. Many times we erect barriers to God who is constantly drawing us to Himself by his grace. This retreat is about letting ourselves be drawn to Him.

"Divine Intimacy" is undoubtedly the classic Carmelite work on meditation -- a book that helps one arrive at intimate union with God by the practice of considering holy truths. It is a book that shows how to join prayer and action and put the Catholic doctrine on the spiritual life into practice daily. "Divine

Intimacy" has been translated into all principal languages and has met with extraordinary success, bringing encouragement and spiritual profit to lay people as well as priests and religious.

For each day of the year, Fr. 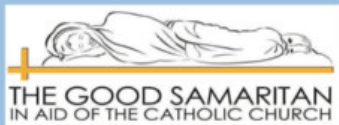

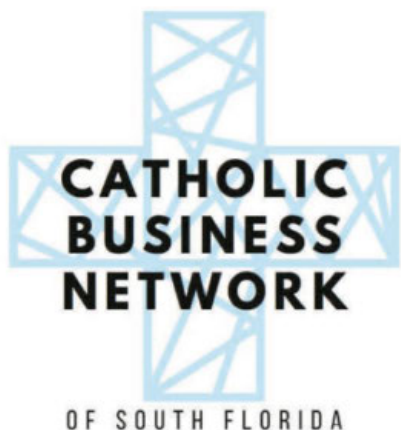

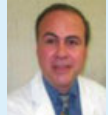
