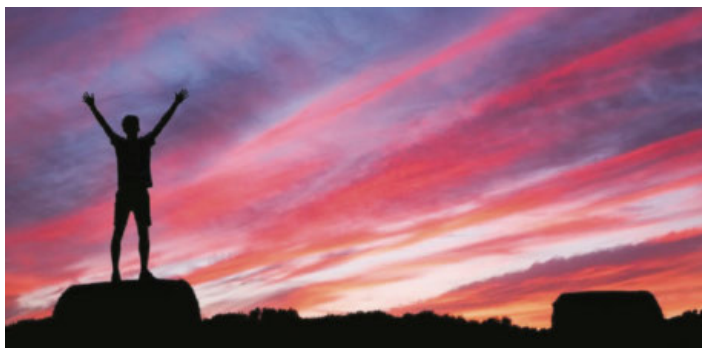

(Ps 66)

Christ sent his disciples ahead of him to announce, with a message of peace, that the reign of God was at hand. We can feel a sense of their joy and wonder that their mission was a success as people flocked to listen and welcome the word of God. The church's task of sending out missionaries is an urgent one and goes on in every age. 'God wishes all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.' Since Christ's own life and mission were confined to a small area of Palestine around Jerusalem, he was looking out on the world and thinking of people of all times and places when he spoke the words: 'The harvest is great but the laborers are few.' He realized that the harvest of souls was countless, the opportunities for saving them plentiful, but that too few people would volunteer for the work of spreading his gospel message. The world would be far more ready to receive the gospel than his followers would be to announce it.

The invitation to take part in the work of the Lord, to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world is extended to our generation. Our mission is to bring the peace of Christ wherever we go and to all we meet. No special training or education is needed for the word of God is waiting to come to birth in a more total way in each of us. All that is required is an effort on our part to allow the goodness of God to shine in our lives. Since the Lord relies on us as his helpers, Christ will be judged on our showing of him. In an age when many are confused and disillusioned, and are searching for meaning in drugs and shallow relationships, we can open their hearts to faith and arouse in them a thirst for God by treating them with courtesy, charity and respect. In the midst of plenty, people are hungering to be wanted, loved and recognized. God alone can satisfy the desire of the human heart and overcome the darkness from within.

Everyday is a harvest day and in every place there are things we can do for Christ which will otherwise remain undone. We are all responsible for some small part of the Lord's work and it is up to us to reap the harvest. We cannot sit back and expect the peace of Christ to appear unexpectedly from heaven without our involvement. To give to others the peace of Christ is the vocation we all share as disciples and the task committed to us. We are called not merely to be good people but to spread the gospel.

*We turn now in prayer to the Lord of the harvest and
we pray for the needs of the church and of the world.*

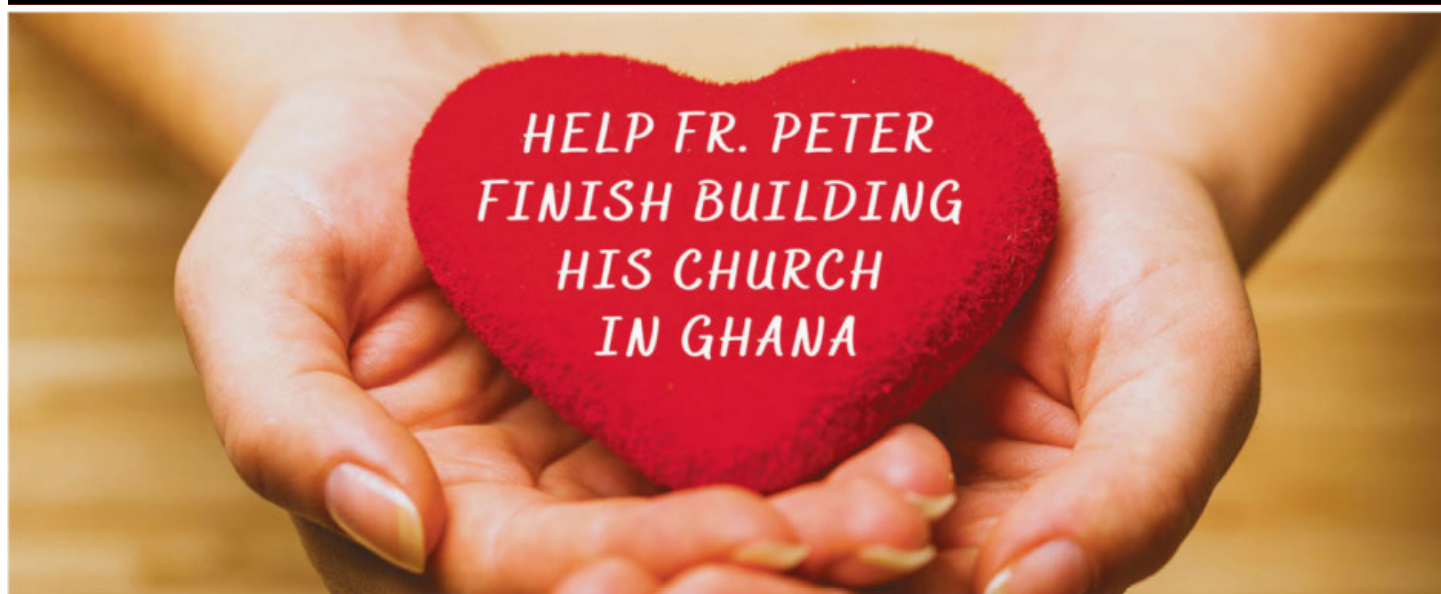

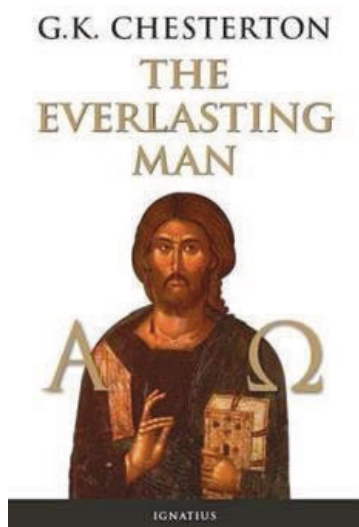

The Everlasting Man By G.K. Chesterton

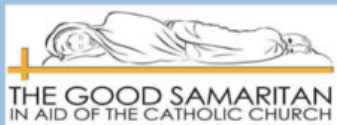

I Must See it to Believe it!



The statement above is counter-productive. Psalms 26:13: 'I believe that I shall see the Lord in the land of the living.' Hebrews 11:1 says, 'Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not apparent.' Faith and belief are the 'stand-ins' until the visible solution appears. 'We walk by faith and not by sight.' (Second Corinthians 5:7). Jesus said to doubting Thomas, "Blessed are those who have not seen but yet have believed." The tangible appears after the intangible (belief, faith) is exercised.

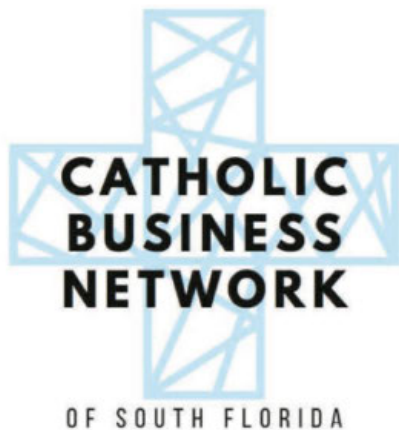
The old nature within us can't exercise faith. During trials, faith is at odds with doubt. That inability makes us miserable. Yet, we have the answer – believe it until we see it and be at peace meanwhile. Our quiet confidence may seem like we have buried our heads in the sand, or that we live in a fool's paradise. God says that we live (survive and flourish) by faith. He has commanded that and won't let us down. Our old nature will try to provoke fear but we can prevent it from occupying our thoughts.

While waiting, we often feel we must do something to help God. But Jesus said, 'Without me you can do nothing.' (John 15:5) Since it is our faith God is growing, it wouldn't grow if we could solve our problems on the spot. He makes that impossible in the trials we are immersed in. Otherwise, faith would be irrelevant. But what isn't possible for us is possible for God.

What are you struggling with? If it is too big for you, it is time to believe until you see. The point of it all is to see the answer ultimately. Faith is about thanking God for it until it arrives. When our old nature tells us to panic, we simply answer, 'What are you talking about? The answer is on the way and I will be ok until then.'

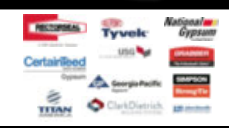
