Fourth Sunday of Easter: Good Shepherd Sunday




From the Journal of Fr. Jared

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

After the First Reading at Mass, there is often a brief pause and usually a change of lectors.


A cantor or a member of the choir typically comes up to lead the people in a Psalm. This sung reading is called a Responsorial Psalm because the cantor will say the response aloud, and then we will echo his response until the end of the Psalm. In between the responses, the cantor will sing or recite the stanzas of Hebrew poetry. The Psalms are mostly written by King David and are God's own inspired hymnal. The Psalms are often called the School of Prayer because they are filled with authentic expressions of human emotion that many have felt at times, as well as being prayers to God. The whole gamut of human experience is often expressed throughout the Psalms.

The call and response nature of the Responsorial Psalm is very prominent throughout the Mass. The Psalm is to be meditated upon, partly why it is sung and not simply read aloud at a Sunday Mass. However, many Catholics have this weird phenomenon where they hear the Psalm response once and subsequently forget what the cantor or lector said. It happens to me, too. Though I am not a fan of reading the readings out of missalettes or the hymnals at Mass, the Church does not expressly forbid it, and in case of the Psalm, I would encourage you to read along, especially for content of the stanzas and the response.

In light of the joyous nature of the


Easter and Christmas Seasons, traditionally the priest
