Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

**Journal of Fr. Jared** After the Psalm is chanted or sung, the cantor/lector leaves the sanctuary and then bows to the altar alongside the lector for the

Second Reading. As the second lector enters the sanctuary, they proclaim a reading from the New Testament that does not come from the Gospels. Typically, it is from one of the many epistles/ letters, an excerpt from the Acts of the Apostles (except during Easter), or the Book of Revelation. The reading is introduced like the First Reading by the name of the book only, not by chapter and verse.

After the Second Reading is concluded, the lector leaves the sanctuary, bows to the altar, and returns to their seat. After a few moments of silence, the priest and/or deacon (if present) stand, and then typically the Alleluia is sung or chanted by the choir and then by all. The Alleluia, which means "Praise the Lord" in Hebrew, is never to just be recited like the other readings.


If there is a deacon at Mass, then they go before the priest or bishop celebrating the Mass for a blessing. They ask, "Your blessing, Father/Bishop" as they bow before the celebrant. The celebrant prays, "May the Lord be in your heart and on your lips, that you may proclaim his Gospel worthily and well, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." The deacon signs himself with the Sign of the Cross upon the invocation of the name of the Trinity, goes to the middle of the sanctuary, elevates the Book of the Gospels, and then proceeds to the ambo to proclaim the Gospel. Sometimes, incense and candles are used in the Gospel procession.
