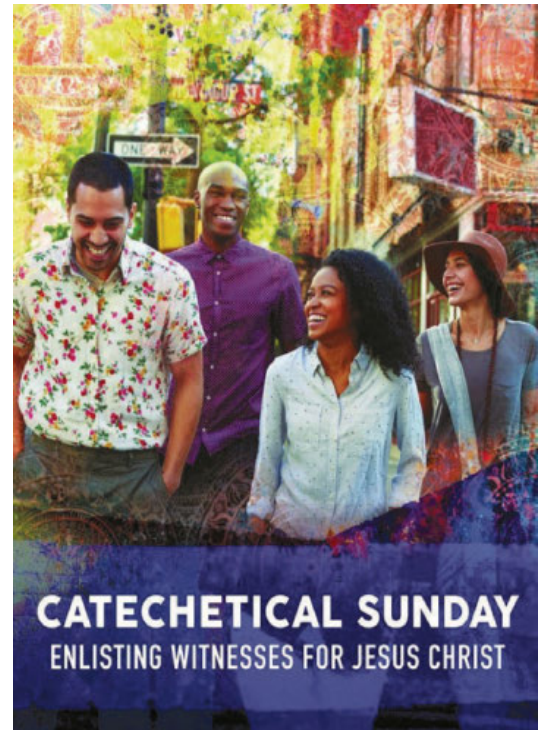
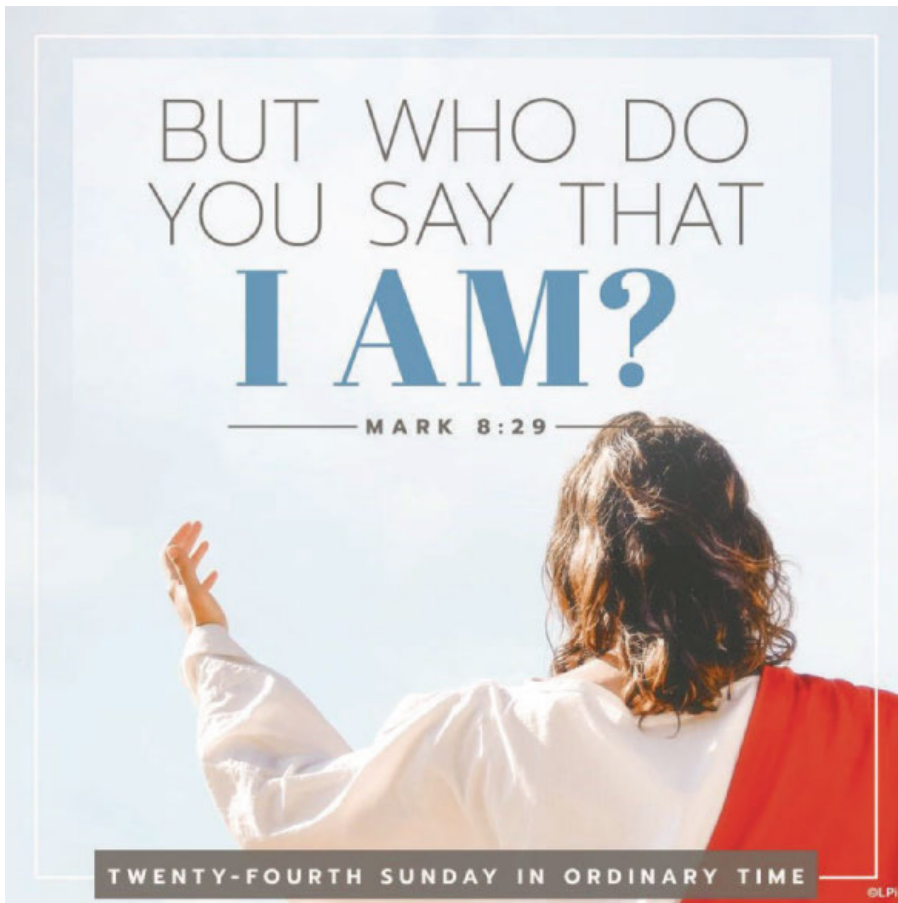

Plan to attend Mass, Adoration, and a potluck on Sept 20th at St. Benedict the Moor at 7 PM!

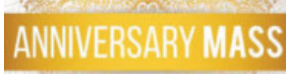
