All Saints Day and All Souls Day

All Saints Day, a Holy Day of Obligation, will be this coming Friday, Nov 1st. Masses will be held at St. Monica's on Friday at 8:30 AM and 7:00 PM.

This year, All Souls Day (Nov 2nd) falls on a Saturday. Since that evening will be the Vigil Mass for Sunday, we will have our All Souls Day Mass at the St. Monica Cemetery (321 Osceola Street in Palatka) at 10 AM on Saturday, Nov 2nd. This will take the place of our regular First Saturday Morning Mass time at 8:30 AM. Although All Souls Day is not a Holy Day of Obligation, we hope you can join us for Mass at the Cemetery!

Second Collection Next Weekend (Nov 2-3) for the St. Monica Cemetery

During the month of November, we remember our loved ones who have gone before us. Next weekend (Nov 2-3), churches in our Diocese will take up a special collection for the Diocesan Cemeteries. Since St. Monica's has our own cemetery, 100% of the proceeds from next weekend's second collection will go toward our own St. Monica Cemetery. Please be generous!

This year, during the month of November, we will have a Book of the Dead on a small lectern in the back of church, so that you can inscribe the names of your loved ones who have gone before us. The Book of the Dead will take the place of the tables holding pictures that we have had in the past, in order to provide more space in our small church. During the month of November, we will pray for those whose names are written in the Book of the Dead.


