From the Journal of Fr. Jared

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Now after a long hiatus, I am returning to my walkthrough of the Mass by beginning our discussion on the Liturgy of the

Eucharist. The Liturgy of the Eucharist begins with the Offertory or Collection on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, where we fulfill the fifth precept: that we are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his or her own ability. In addition to the collection of monies and checks, gift bearers bring up the wine and unleavened bread that will be consecrated into the Eucharist at that particular Mass.


In the past, people would bring up other material items as well, including the works of their labor like the harvest, goods they made, animals, etc. The ordinary elements are brought up to be changed into the sacred. This procession is usually accompanied by the offertory chant or some sort of music, even if there is no procession. The priest will then receive the gifts that are brought up and go behind the altar to begin the preparation of the gifts. Just as the ambo is the center of the Liturgy of the Word; the altar is the center of the whole Liturgy of the Eucharist. It is not just a table for the bread and wine to be consecrated, but rather the place that the priest participates in the one unbloody sacrifice of Jesus Christ commemorated at every single Mass. Just like the Old Testament priests, Catholic priests make sacrifice on altars.
