

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

After the priest washes his hands in preparation, he returns to directly behind the altar. He then extend his hands and joins them together again, saying, "Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the Almighty Father." Not only is the prayer directed to God the Father, as all liturgical prayer is, but the people are invited to express their approval of the sacrifice of the Mass as well as reminded that they, too, are called to bring their own sacrifices and prayer intentions to Mass.

The people, who stand as the celebrant addresses them, respond, "May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church." The people are not invited to extend their hands in response to the priest celebrant since the priest celebrant extends his hands to pray on behalf of the people.


Then the Priest, with hands extended, says the Prayer over the Offerings, at the end of which the people acclaim: Amen. This prayer is one of the three presidential prayers said for each Mass alongside the Collect and the Prayer After Communion, who normally begin with the invitation, "Let us pray."
