Moving Forward & FAQs

Friends,

It's with a heavy heart and sorrow that I share the news that Deacon Jim Hinnerschitz is no longer a member of the pastoral staff at Frassati. Amidst grieving his departure these past days, I began to pray for consolation from the Holy Comforter for him and his family and for those he inspired through his ministry here and St. James in Conway. My prayer — that I hope will become our united prayer — for consolation from the Holy Spirit has had two parts.

First, I've recalled with gratitude, Deacon Jim's years of service and friendship. I'm eternally grateful for everything Deacon Jim and his wife Tami did to assist me in my priestly ministry since I arrived in Myrtle Beach in August 2018. Together, we built the campus ministry program and the Newman Center at Coastal Carolina University. Together, in 2019, we traveled to Italy with Bishop Guglielmone for his bi-centennial celebration pilgrimage. Together, we served at St. James in Conway. And together, over the past five years, we have "birthed" (with sweat, blood and tears) Frassati Catholic Church with the grace of the Holy Spirit. I officiated at their daughter's wedding, baptized their two youngest grandchildren, and have shared in many of their family celebrations.

As I told Deacon Jim on Wednesday morning, he inspired in me a fresh outlook on the permanent diaconate with his servant heart and the rolling up of his sleeves. The diaconate was never about being seen or a glamorous ornament on the altar. His selfless service behind the scenes quickly inspired Deacon Jeff Vehige to pursue the diaconate for our parish and more recently has inspired Brian O'Neill to discern the diaconate for our parish as well. To sum it up, Deacon Jim, Tami, and I had what Saint Paul in biblical Greek calls *koinonia*— fellowship, communion, shared experiences of love and faith, many a shared meals and laughs together by ourselves and with other parishioners (cf. 2 Cor 13:13).

Second, as sorrowful as I am for the loss of Deacon Jim from our community, I find consolation in looking toward the horizon, toward the bright future of our parish that he helped shape from day one. We have proven to be a resilient and tenacious community. We have overcome great obstacles since before we even said our first Mass in this hallway: frictions with neighboring parishes, the diocese, and the school which has undergone multiple leadership changes.

Moreover, as Deacon Jim has helped in the transition of our business manager and other clerical and pastoral staff the past two months, other parishioners have generously stepped up and filled many of the gaps that his departure creates, and I know that many more will fill the holes that remain. As the expression goes, "many hands make light work." And we have many hundreds more than at our first 11am Mass in July of 2020.

Please join me in continued prayers for Deacon Jim and his family as they transition to new adventures. May their adventures be true, good and beautiful. And may the Holy Spirit shower upon our parish family more disciples willing to utilize their gifts for the building up of the kingdom of God in Carolina Forest.

Building the Good Adventure: Initial Parish Campus

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$2.3 million, of which \$1,989,176 has been collected. *When paying your **Pledge**, please write **Capital Campaign and your envelope number** in the memo area of your check.*

Leverage your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) to help us build the good adventure.

Starting at age 73, or at a younger age if inherited, the IRS mandates owners of IRAs to take annual income withdrawals, known as **Required Minimum Distributions (RMD)** to avoid penalties. Retirement-age individuals and couples may not want to take an RMD for specific reasons. For example, the withdrawal, which is subject to ordinary income tax, may push them into a higher tax bracket, which can have adverse impacts on Social Security payments and Medicare benefits.

Individuals and couples age 70½ and older have a tax-smart strategy called a **Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)**, also known as a charitable IRA rollover. The QCD allows a donor to instruct an IRA administrator to send up to \$108,000 per year (\$216,000 for married couples filing jointly) to one or more qualifying charities.

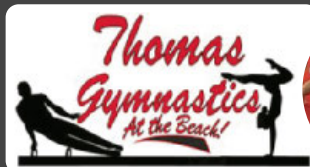

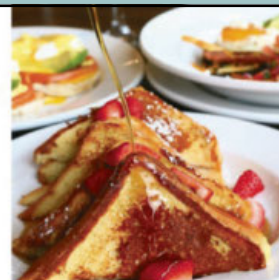
