The Holy Gospel for today presents another parable. This one is about the generosity of the vineyard owner. The parables of Jesus often feature an inverting of the expectations of the world. When he does this, it shows us that the reign of God was, is and will be an upside-down reality from what we would normally expect.



Dear Friends in Christ,

As you recall, the pandemic brought our observance of the Sacred Triduum to a halt earlier this year. With Good Friday services in our churches not open to the public, there was no opportunity for the traditional Holy Land Collection to be gathered. However, the need for support of Christians in the Holy Land remains great. It is my hope that you will respond to that need as we focus on a collection on September 26-27, 2020. This is the opportunity when we respond to the direction of the Holy Father and reach out to assist our sisters and brothers in the Holy Land.


