CATECHISM CORNER:

Last week's question: **How are the sacraments of the Church divided?** <u>ANSWER:</u> The sacraments are divided into: the sacraments of Christian initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist); the sacraments of healing (Penance and Anointing of the Sick); and the sacraments at the service of communion and mission (Holy Orders and Matrimony). The sacraments touch all the important moments of Christian life. All of the sacraments are ordered to the Holy Eucharist "as to their end" (Saint Thomas Aquinas).

Over the past month I've taken it upon myself to volunteer with Joppa Homeless Outreach after Mass, and all of us there are working hard to get the homeless the help they need, which culminates in getting them off the street. With mental health and addiction issues we work slowly developing trust so that we can approach them and facilitate change. I ask you all to remember Christ's commandment in love of neighbor and help with contributions to assist Joppa this summer.

These are some of the items that are most needed at present:

-Flip top, canned hearty meals (pasta, hearty soups, chicken, etc.) and other non-perishables

-AAA and AA batteries (especially AAA)

-small tubes of Triple Antibiotic ointment

-DART bus tokens

-DEET insect repellant

-body wipes

-sunscreen

-toilet paper

-small boxes or pods of laundry soap

-socks, new or gently used

Last day to drop off items is Sunday, July 18th. Boxes are located in the vestibule of the church and in the parish hall.

If you wish to donate clothes, they cannot be accepted at the Basilica, but Joppa would gladly accept them at River Plaza, 2326 Euclid Avenue.
