Please note that we are falling behind in our budget needs. We are **\$51,536.61** short of needed income. I ask you all to step up to the plate to see that we remain financially stable. Our deficit grows every week. We cannot take up a collection yet so please avail yourselves of the online option and the secure boxes and the baskets in the Basilica. We also still owe \$42,461.00 for the 2020 ADA. We need to stay ahead of the financial side of things before we get much farther behind. The Lord bless you all!
