My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Holy Gospel reminds us today that fraternal correction is sometimes necessary. Resolving conflicts is often difficult. In the context of the Church it can be downright tricky. Disciples are called to continual discernment through the Holy Spirit for the well-being of the community, and their behavior must always be in agreement with Gospel teaching.

Annual Seminarian Collection Diocese of Des Moines September 12 -13, 2020

Dear Reverend Monsignors, Fathers, and Deacons,

Fall signals the return of students and faculty back to school, including our nineteen diocesan seminarians. As you know, formation of a priestly vocation is a commitment of deep prayer and financial support on the part of the entire faith community and each seminarian. An annual seminarian collection taken up in mid-September each year supplements support from the Annual Diocesan Appeal and the endowed seminarian fund at the Catholic Foundation of Southwest Iowa. This year more than \$250,000 is needed to enable the academic formation of our seminarians.

Funds are used to cover tuition, room and board, and provide a small monthly stipend for the pretheologians and theologians. The college seminarians are expected to help pay for some of their tuition, but the diocese provides a grant each year to reduce their tuition to a level comparable to Iowa's regents' universities. With scholarships and loans the men are able to graduate with little debt. Those in advanced theological study or theologians rely entirely on the support of the faith community.

On Saturday, September 12 and Sunday, September 13, I am asking every parish to provide an opportunity for the faithful to participate in the annual collection for our diocesan seminarians. I advise each parish to provide an extra collection basket marked for the seminarian collection over this weekend. Moreover, each registered household will receive a brochure and return envelope through the mail. They may return their gift directly to the Diocese, place the gift in the parish collection, or make a gift online at dmdiocese.org/giving.

Also provided with this mailing are petitions and bulletin announcements for use in promoting this special collection. Please announce this appeal during the weekends of September 5 and 12. The repetition in the announcements will help call special attention to the appeal and will assist us in reaching as many people as possible.

Please accept my genuine gratitude for your generous participation. May God continue to send us many more workers for the harvest!
