In these Sundays of St. John's Bread of Life Discourse, we explore the many ways that people reacted to that presence in their midst. How do we react during the solemn liturgy, especially when we come up to Holy Communion?

I also remind everyone that there is a minimum of a one hour Eucharistic fast before receiving Holy Communion unless there is a health or physical reason.




Back to School Needs
