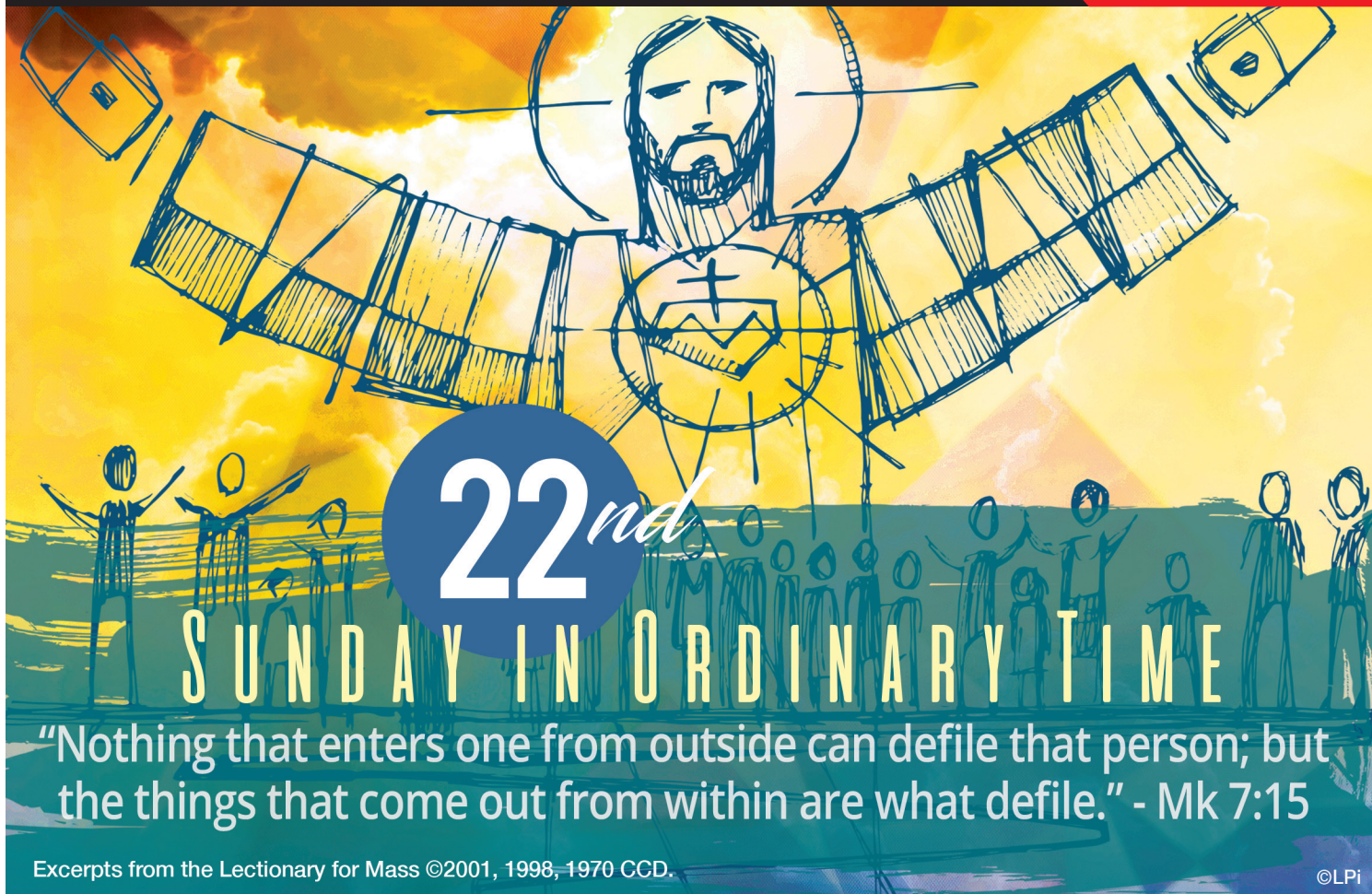

Once you enter the **church of St. Peter** in Lindsay by passing under the entrance archway, you will find a startling yet amazing collection of colorful Byzantine and abstract geometric designs covering the walls. The current church, built in 1918 is the church structure on the site. Due to underlying water damage to the colorful plaster, the church was restored in 2009. Houston's **Cathedral of Our Lady of Walsingham** is the headquarters of the Personal Ordinariate of the Chair of St. Peter.

The Ordinariate is similar to a diocese created in 2012 for former Anglican communities and clergy who are now in full communion with Rome but retaining elements of Anglican heritage. ## Facts for Faithful Kids

**1. August 31** is the feast of St. Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus. Nicodemus was an important Jew who secretly met with Jesus to learn about His teachings. Later, Nicodemus spoke up in favor of Jesus at His trial. St. Joseph of Arimathea was an important and wealthy Jew who had become a follower of Jesus. After the Crucifixion, St. Joseph went to Pilate to ask for the body of Jesus so He could be buried. It took a lot of courage to speak to Pilate. St. Joseph is the patron saint of funeral directors.

**2. Have you ever slept on a train? On September 1, 1859** the first sleeping car was added to a train. It was not very comfortable but it did let people sleep on a bed instead of sitting up in a chair, especially on train rides that could last for days!

**3. Have you ever heard of VJ Day? This important celebration** is held on **September 2**. On that day in 1945, the Japanese government signed documents officially surrendering. World War II had come to an end. There were huge celebrations in cities all over the United States. If you have never heard the stories, now is a good time to ask your grandma or grandpa. Say a prayer for everyone who died or was injured in war.

**4. Pope Gregory the Great wanted to be a monk and work in** the monastery. But God had bigger plans for him. Elected pope at age 50, Gregory worked to improve the priesthood, rescue captive slaves, bring order to church laws, and care for victims of famine and the plague. His feast day is **September 3**. Pope Gregory knew that he needed to follow the call of Jesus. What is God calling you to do for others?
