Let Us Pray

This week we will focus on the third type of prayer, Contemplation.

Contemplative prayer is a search for God, to go deep within to find the one who loves us and realize that the Holy Spirit has a chapel in our souls.

St. Teresa said, "Contemplative prayer [oracion mental] in my opinion is nothing else than a close sharing between friends; it means taking time frequently to be alone with him who we know loves us. Contemplative prayer seeks him "whom my soul loves." It is Jesus, and in him, the Father. We seek him, because to desire him is always the beginning of love, and we seek him in that pure faith which causes us to be born of him and to live in him. In this inner prayer we can still meditate, but our attention is fixed on the Lord himself." CCC 2709

The church explains that entering into contemplative prayer is like entering into the Eucharistic liturgy: we "gather up:" the heart, recollect our whole being under the prompting of the Holy Spirit and abide in the dwelling place of the Lord. We let our masks fall and turn our hearts back to the Lord who loves us. We hand ourselves over to him as an offering to be purified and transformed.

We turn to God as His children, as forgiven sinners who want to know His love more intimately and to respond by loving Him with all our being. Having an intimate relationship with God is a gift and one we should cultivate.
