News from PEACE & JUSTICE

Ohio Faith Communities for Death Penalty Abolition Week

This week (October 8-17), faith communities across Ohio are joining together to call for the abolition of the death penalty. As Catholics, we believe in a consistent ethic of life, which extends from conception to natural death. Capital punishment contradicts this ethic. Pope Francis has updated the Catechism of the Catholic Church to say that "the death penalty is inadmissible because it is an attack on the ... dignity of the person." Currently the Ohio Legislature is working on two bills, HB 183 and SB 103, identical bills that would repeal Ohio's death penalty. It appears that the momentum to repeal the death penalty in Ohio is at an all-time high, though passage is not guaranteed. Ohio state Rep. Jean Schmidt (R-Loveland) has concluded that the death penalty is "imperfect, unfair, expensive, and incompatible with pro-life views." We encourage you to take time this week to contact your Ohio legislators and encourage them to support HB 183 and SB 103.



In appreciation of the beauty of God's creation that surrounds us here in southern and central Ohio, St. Clare Parish is encouraging each family to pick up and dispose of at least one plastic or paper bag of litter from anywhere in the archdiocese—the block where you live, a nearby park, river bank, parking lot, anywhere you see the earth has been trashed.

Our goal is 200 bags, one for each year of the bicentennial.
