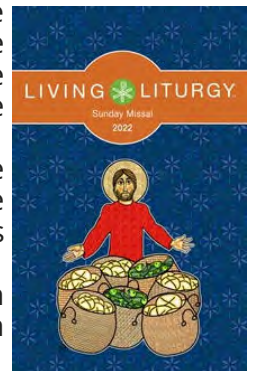
2022 Living Liturgy Sunday Missal
