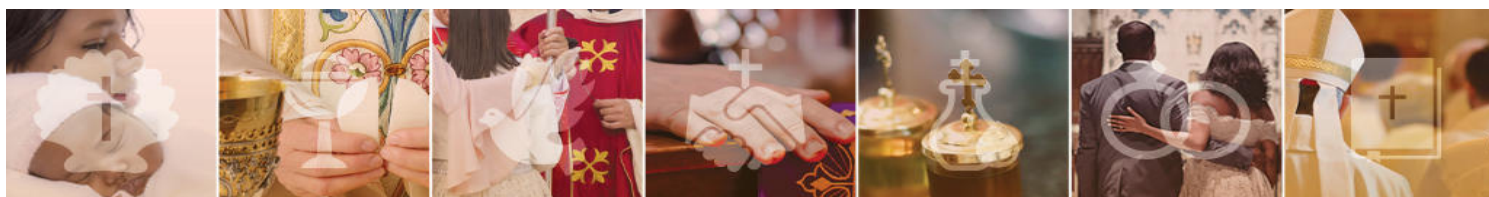

Engaged couples must make an appointment with the pastor at least six months in advance of the wedding date. Please contact the parish office.

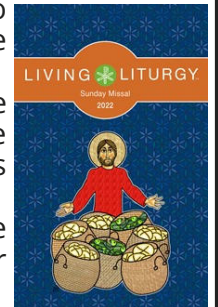
2022 Living Liturgy Sunday Missal

If you would like to purchase your own personal copy of the **2022 Living Liturgy Sunday Missal**, please see Darin after Mass this weekend.

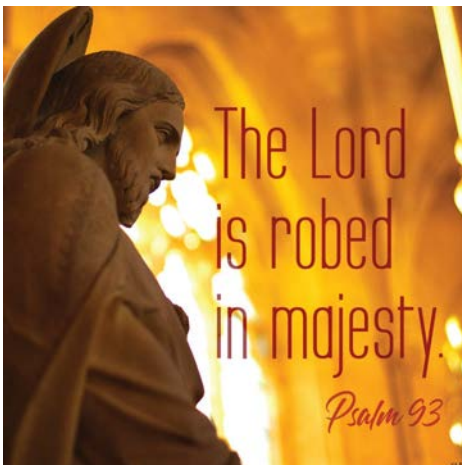
Each copy costs \$5. Due to the pandemic, Darin will not be able to provide change, so it would be helpful if you can be sure to have a \$5 bill.
