NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR— DIANE

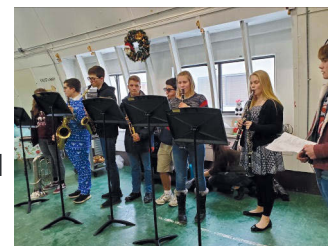

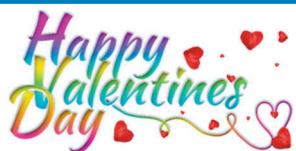
AARP FOUNDATION TAX-AID PROGRAM

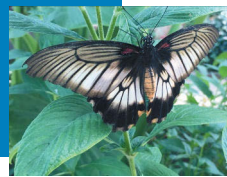

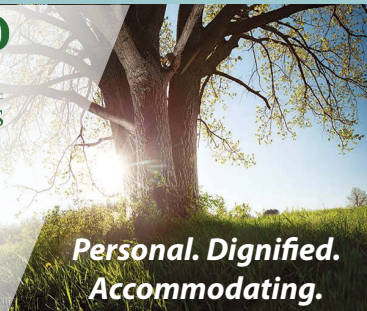
