Dear Parishioners,

Greetings of peace and prayerful wishes from Fr. Raj. At the outset, I thank everyone for your prayerful support during the week of my retreat which was on the theme of MISSION. The retreat was indeed informative and inspiring. The retreat talks were focused on how one needs to carry forward the mission entrusted by Jesus to His apostles and thereafter to each one of us. Today, in the given situation of the world of pandemic filled with fear and anxiety, many of us have lost the track with the Lord.
