#### Being True Witnesses

You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. Acts 1:8

The Ascension of the Lord represents the great handoff of Christian life when we are given the responsibility by Jesus to *witness* to him throughout the world. In one sense, we witness when we openly profess our faith to the world in words and/or actions. The word *martyr* means witness in this sense, a witness that results in literal death.

A witness also gives evidence of the truth, as we Christians do when we take Jesus seriously. We become witnesses of who he is and what he has done in our lives. Unfortunately, the reverse is also true: When we do not take Jesus seriously, our lives are often taken as proof of the falsehood of Christian claims.

As we celebrate the Ascension, let us renew our commitment to be true witnesses to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
