- Why did Jesus, the all-holy Son of God, seek John's baptism of repentance? It was not to receive (for he is himself the source of all grace) but to give. "Christ is baptized, not to be made holy by the water, but to make the water holy, and by his cleansing to purify the waters He touched"—St. Maximus of Turin
- Christ's baptism reveals to us what our own baptism now accomplishes: the forgiveness of sin and a share in His divine sonship. The words heard from the heavens could be said about every person baptized since.
 "Baptism places upon our souls a mark that forever will identify it as one privileged of God"—Sister Mary Jean Darcy, O.P.
- Do you know the date of your baptism? This day is as important as your birthday. You should celebrate it because you were born into the family of God. Baptism frees us from sin and makes us (as mentioned above) a "Child of God". The indelible mark on your soul is forever your proof of it. Celebrate that day when it comes around, especially your children's baptism. They will never forget that day and how special it is for them.
- At one NCYC in Indy, we were on an elevator in our hotel and some men who had a lot of tattoos got on with us. We had our youth group stuff on and the conversation went something like this: One of the men asked, "Church convention?" We said, "Yes." He said something like "Stick with your faith kids." Then he said, "You know what my favorite tattoo is?"(He raised his hand to his chest.) "No one can see it but it's the one God put on my soul when I was baptized."
- What a life lesson that was! I don't remember who was with me but I've never forgotten that elevator ride. And I don't ride many elevators but sometimes that comes to mind when I'm on one. You never know when God is going to show Himself through others.
- Jesus not only received Baptism today, but also Confirmation by the Holy Spirit descending upon Him and the Father's words of Love and Praise. He received fully the gifts of the Holy Spirit in an enhanced way to give Him the encouragement He needed to do the Will of the Father and strengthen His human nature.
- I'm going to try to find a day and time to have a set bimonthly get together for faith building, Bible study, book sessions, and other kinds of topics and things to enrich our faith. Stay tuned. It will be a challenge but it will work out in the end.
