After dinner, Deacon Chuong will give testimony on his story of coming here from Vietnam as a refugee.

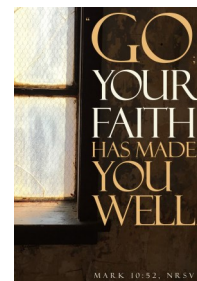

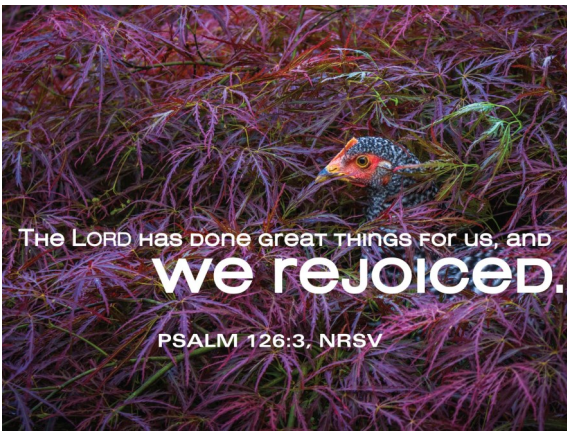
