Message from Father Matthew:

Liturgical Q & A:

Q. Dear Father, I noticed over the past few weeks that the priest has worn different colors of vestments. Why is this so?

A. The priest wears different colors in accordance with the seasons, feasts, and solemnities that are celebrated throughout the liturgical year. Here is an explanation of when and why each color is used:

Purple/Violet is the color of penance and is used during Advent and Lent in anticipation of Christmas & Easter.

Rose/Pink is the color of anticipation & joy and is only used on the third Sunday in Advent and the fourth Sunday during Lent (Gaudete & Laetare Sundays).

Green is the color of hope, life, and growth and is used throughout Ordinary Time.

Red is the color of sacrifice and is used during Passion (Palm) Sunday, Good Friday, Exaltation of the Holy Cross, Pentecost, and the feasts of the apostles and the saints who were martyred.

White/Gold is the color of joy & purity and are used during the Easter and Christmas seasons as well as the feasts of the Blessed Virgin Mary, angels, and saints who were not martyred.


