

GOSPEL PROCLAMATION

PROFESSION OF FAITH—Nicene Creed I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen


