

Members present: Dan McNeill (President), Shayla Findley (Secretary), Alex Pettit, Jerry Travis (Trustee), Michelle Moore, Absent: Sharon Swanson. Alex motioned to approve the May minutes, Shayla seconded, motion carried. All reviewed the end year June financial documents. For FY2022, St. Edward will pay 15% rather than 20% of Paul VI costs. ADA goal was made on July 18. There was some discussion on hiring a Director of Religious Education (DRE) for St. Edward. Alex motioned to approve hiring a DRE. Fr. Adam will contact the possible candidate. **Unfinished business:** Alex painted the Bell Tower ceiling. Dan commented that the Knights of Columbus are discussing ways to move the piano/organ to the choir loft and how to fix or replace the church oven. New business: The Annual Financial Report of 2021 was reviewed and signed. Jerry Travis and Sheila Brown will remain trustees for FY2022. The west A/C unit was repaired. Jerry Travis volunteered to be a parish council member. We still need 1 female to have all positions filled. Jerry mentioned the 2014 Bylaws read that meetings are held every month. Michelle will look for more current Bylaws copy. Shayla motioned to approve Michelle as view access to bank account, Alex seconded, motion carried. Fr. Adam discussed more ideas about the 40 hrs. Adoration. Possibly starting Sunday afternoon and going to Tuesday morning. The cash counting policy was discussed. There will be a sign-up sheet at the back of the church to ask for volunteers to help count tithes with a parish council member. Meeting ended in prayer. Alex motioned to adjourn meeting, Shayla seconded, motion carried. Next meeting will be Sept 19.

Practicing Graciousness in the Desert. Looking back over my journey of parenthood, I know there were days when I traveled the extra mile for my children. I made their toast the way they like it, let them play in the park an extra ten minutes, or let them go to the movies with their friends and I finished up the chores on my own. And then, it happened: the attitude. The request for the smallest thing from one of them is met with disdain or bewilderment. Sometimes you can be made breathless with the ingratitude of another person who takes so much and with so little shame, only to scoff at the idea that they, too, give even the smallest amount. But if we're being honest with ourselves, we will admit that we do the exact same thing to God. Haven't we all been the Israelites in the desert at one point or another? God has parted our Red Sea in some way. He's led us out of some great trial, given us some great blessings. But then we run into a little resistance somewhere along the way and we throw up our hands. How could you do this to us, Lord? How could you ask this of us? No, I can't go any further. No, I won't do any more. Persisting in the blindness to the many ways God continues to protect us is nothing short of a temper tantrum. It robs our Everyday Stewardship of its graciousness, of our ability to accept with joy the trials of life be-



cause we are also constantly aware of its blessings.—

What's Your Hearth Cake? "Get up and eat, or the jour-

ney will be too much for you." I've been to a lot of meetings in my years of work in the Church, and you can take my word for it: the ones with snacks just seem to go better. I don't know what it is exactly. Maybe it's just that people are in a more agreeable mood if you show up with donuts. Or maybe it's about the very real sense of community and camaraderie that is created at a table where people are engaging in that most human of tasks — eating — beside

one another. I think a big part of it comes down to the simple fact that we're all just nicer people when we're fed. This rings true spiritually, too. We simply must remain fed if we, in turn, are to feed others. Think of a time when you have neglected your relationship with God — when you haven't fed yourself with whatever it is that you need to remain committed to the journey of a Christian life. Is it Mass attendance? Is it prayer or Scripture reading? Is it time with your small group, or conversation with a trusted friend who knows your soul? What sustains your ability to be a good disciple, a good steward? What inspires you to give more freely, to love more abundantly? Whatever it is, that's your hearth cake. That's your jug of water.
