

HOLY SPIRIT PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MINUTES

February 16, 2021 The Council met Tuesday, February 16, at Holy Spirit Hall following social distancing and mask protocols. President Phyllis Allen called the meeting to order. Fr. Adam led the opening prayer. Members present: Mark O'Riley, Phyllis Allen, Lisa Miller, Barb Hudson, Fr. Adam, Ronda Katzer, Joni Thelen, Joni Taylor, Jacquie Eblen, and Michelle Moore. Motion by Mark, second by Barb to approve the January minutes. Motion carried. Father's comments: 1) Bible Study has 15 people registered and starts Feb. 21. 2) Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) training is being planned at St. Edward. Fr. is planning to attend the training and will also be available for both St. Edward and Holy Spirit Parishioners in hopes to increase the number of catechists at St. Edward. The class will also be available to other churches to meet the minimum class size. Contact Fr. Adam if you are interested in more info. 3)Holy Spirit men's restroom remodel is completed. 4) There were approximately 37 families that visited STM preschool program this year. Fr. Adam has been working on the marketing efforts (radio, newspaper, FB) to promote the STM preschool program. 5) Fr. Adam has been asked to help the Diocese of DesMoines on Cannon Law research projects. Committee Reports: Building & Grounds: Mark is going to look into changing the basement light to all LED. The NW light by the kitchen is being repaired. The kitchen needs to be cleaned before the Foundation meals can be distributed on Saturday. Since the Bishop is allowing social events, we will be having more activities in the basement. There was some discussion on hiring a cleaning person for the church. Family Life: Discussed doing Donut Sundays after Lent. Social Concerns: The Food Shelf is also distributing meals at Diagonal and Orient.. Liturgy Committee: Decorating for Lent. Finance: Next meeting is March. Sue McEntee will be a guest speaker to discuss Catholic Foundation of Southwest lowa. Faith formation: Religious Education is going strong, even due to the Covid issues. Subs have helped and the current catechists have put in great effort and time into the program. There will be a need for more volunteers next year as the Freshman class will be large. Feb. 28 is the 8th Grade retreat. Sophomores are on track for Confirmation. This year's freshman class did an amazing job cleaning last month at the church for service hours. This month they sent Valentine cards to a various parishioner at Holy Spirit and St. Edwards. Also they sent to the Care Group in Afton and some residents at Imagine the Possibilities in Creston. RCIA: Classes are going well. There might be 2 more people interested for the next RCIA class. There was some discussion on how to inform non-Catholic parents of St. Malachy students about future RCIA classes. There was discussion on how many Catholics are not engaged in the faith. St. Malachy School: The school auction hosted by the Foundation is Feb. 27th. Details can be found on Facebook. Rerun: The Parish Council agreed to open the bathrooms and dressing rooms.


