Baptized in the Lord

Good afternoon! I wanted to invite you and your church body to a county-wide prayer event on **Monday, July 13**. We plan to host a prayer at McKinley Park in Creston from 6:00-7:00 p.m. and another hour-long prayer at the city park in Afton from 7:15-8:15 p.m. Those wishing to attend both locations are welcome to leave the Creston event early to arrive to the Afton event by 7:15 p.m.

This community prayer event is not affiliated with any denomination or organization. We simply want our local Christian believers to come together and pray for our communities during these turbulent times.

So what will this event look like? All pastors from Union County are welcome to get up and pray at one or both locations. (We will have a PA system so everyone can hear clearly.) Those in attendance who are not pastors are welcome to pray along silently. People will be encouraged to bring lawn chairs and respect social distancing guidelines. We also plan to live stream these events on our Facebook event page to allow those restricted to their homes to join in.

In addition, we will have a **week-long virtual event** coinciding with our evening of prayer. On Facebook, people will be encouraged to pray at home about a specific topic each day. Below is a *tentative* topic schedule:

Sunday, July 12: Unity/peace

Monday, July 13: Leaders (spiritual/political)

Tuesday, July 14: Youth

Wednesday, July 15: Families

Thursday, July 16: Economy (local/national)

Friday, July 17: Those who serve us (law enforcement/military/veterans/schools/health care)

Saturday, July 18: Asking God to draw people to the Lord
