
FROM FR. KEN

This week, I will be going to Conception Abbey to be on a retreat with a number of the brother priests of the diocese. On a retreat we get out of our daily and normal routine to concentrate exclusively on our relationship with God. They can be challenging as well as very rewarding. One of the challenging parts for me is to let go of the daily routine, the need to be connected to others and what is going on at the parishes, and to try and stop worrying about all of the things that are left to do in this busy time. On my retreat, it takes me to at least the middle of the first day to settle down and relax enough that I can get into the spirit of the retreat. Each of us prays slightly differently and thus our retreat experiences will be different, which is why there are different kinds of spiritual retreats. Some people really like the guided and more casual retreats, where you have a director who gives a series of talks and then you go and reflect on them alone or discuss them with others. Others prefer a more focused retreat where you have the presentation and then you are completely silent. I had the blessing of doing an eight-day silent retreat. This was eight days of no talking except with a spiritual director and no phones, TV, Internet, etc. It was a wonderful experience, and one day I hope to do a 30-day silent retreat. It is a requirement that priests go on a retreat at least once a year so that we can take that time to spend with God. Know that during this week I will be praying for everyone in the parishes as well as for myself to be the priest that God wants me to be and the priest the people I serve need me to be.


