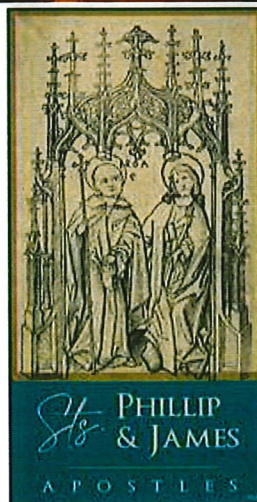
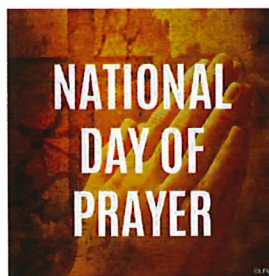

Holy Spirit Parish Council members met Tuesday, April 20, at Holy Spirit Hall. President Phyllis Allen called the meeting to order. Fr. Adam led the opening prayer. Members present: Mark O'Riley, Phyllis Allen, Barb Hudson, Fr. Adam, Ronda Katzer, Joni Taylor, Jacquie Eblen, Lisa Miller, Joni Thelen and Michelle Moore. Absent: Ronda Katzer. Motion by Lisa, second by Mark to approve the March minutes. Motion carried. **Pastor Fr. Adam's Comments:** 1) Enrollment for preK is going well, there are only 3 open spots. Now marketing efforts will shift to middle school. 2) Rerun expansion is going well. The plans are to add a cold storage area for sorting. SWCC students will be doing the construction of the building. 3) Fr. Adam is wondering if anyone is interested in a Latin Mass? It will take special servers to be trained and is in the idea stage. **Committee Reports:** 1) Building & Grounds: Mark provided a quote for new oven. The council voted to approved the quote and it will be sent to Financial Council. There was some discussion on how to update the church basement. Mark also provide a quote to make additional cabinets were the drying rack is located. It was discussed to have people 1<sup>st</sup> come pick up their dishes to help clean the kitchen. Mark is working on getting the basement lights changed to LED which should bright up the space. He is also working to have a small area of paneling painted to see what it looks like. 2) Family Life: They are planning to bring back Coffee & Donut Sunday, starting June 13<sup>th</sup>. 3) Social Concerns: There were extra Easter baskets left over from the Creston Food Shelf so they were giving to Summit house in Creston, Lenox, and Murray. 4) Liturgy Committee: The Parish Council wanted to thank everyone that decorated for Holy Week, it was beautiful. 5) Finance: No updates, next HS FC meeting May 17<sup>th</sup>. 6) Faith formation: The Sedar meal went well. Barb is getting ready for confirmation and 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist. We need 4 teachers and some helpers to have Bible study this year, looking at June 7-11, 9am-Noon. We have only 1 person committed to be a teacher. If we don't have enough help it will be canceled. 7) RCIA and St. Malachy School -No updates **Other:** 1) Subcommittee: Mark, Phyllis, and Barb will be update the cleaning list. Next they are planning to get 3-4 bids to clean Holy Spirit Church. 2) Ideas for next year budget include; to fix pew tops that have been damaged due to chemicals during Covid, painting kitchen in church basement, kitchen remodel in the rectory, fixing murals in church, cleaning costs for church. Father Adam provided a quote for the remodeling of the kitchen rectory, Mark motioned to approve, Joni seconded. The bid will go to the Finance Council. Mark motioned to Adjourn, Barb seconded. The next meeting is May 18.
