



## HOLY SPIRIT PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MINUTES- Sept. 15, 2020

Holy Spirit Parish Council members met at Holy Spirit Hall. Pastor Father Adam Westphal led the opening prayer. Present were Barb Hudson, Fr. Adam, Jacquie Eblen, Joni Taylor, Phyllis Allen, Joni Thelen, Ronda Katzer, Jennifer Simmons (visitor) and Michelle Moore (recording secretary). Absent: Lisa Miller and Mark O'Riley. Motion was made by Ronda to approve the Aug 2020 meeting minutes, Joni Taylor seconded, all approved.

#### Fr. Adam's Comments:

Latte of Leo's has been well received. The police officers have enjoyed the cards from the St. Malachy students.

Mass attendance on Sunday is increasing. We will start publishing Saturday night as a recording Mass in the bulletin.

The donation Monday is working well at the Rerun. We will continue Monday donation days for September, October, and November. The rerun is still in need of volunteers.

#### **New Business:**

Robotics Team: Jennifer Simmons asked if the Robotic team (made up of many St. Malachy students) could use the toy room in the church basement this year to set up their projects. The group discussed the pros and cons. Jacquie made the motion to let the Robotics team use the toy room, seconded by Joni Taylor, all approved.

#### **Committee Reports:**

Building and Grounds/ Safety Committee: Remodeling of the men's bathroom at Holy Spirit will start sometime this Fall.

Family Life: It was discussed on whether to bring back donut Sunday or not. No decisions were made. The council was interested in helping coordinate the Public Square Rosary Rally, more details to come.

Liturgy: They are decorating the church for Fall and will be working on ways to rope off the pews to look prettier.

*Finance*: August HS Finance Council meeting minutes were handed out to the group.

Faith Formation Report submitted by Barb:: RE started Sept. 9. Grades 1-8<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students are at St. Malachy School. 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are in Holy Spirit because there are 30 of them and we need extra room to social distance. Everything went really well the first night. Barb and the teachers are cleaning their class rooms after RE. First Reconciliation parent meeting was Sept. 13. Three families missed so there will be a make-up meeting. There are 17 kids this year. There are no 1<sup>st</sup> graders.

The meeting ended in prayer. Next meeting will be Oct. 20 at 6:30 p.m. Holy Spirit Hall. Phyllis moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Barb. Meeting adjourned.

## ST. EDWARD PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL MINUTES- Sept. 20, 2020

St. Edward Parish Council members met at St. Edward Church basement. Pastor Father Adam Westphal led the opening prayer. Present were Alex Pettit, Sharon Swanson, Shayla Findley, Dennis Hopkins, Absent Dan McNeill. Council reviewed and approved August Financials. Tithing is down, but is slowly increasing since Mass has opened up. Motion to approve July meeting minutes by Shayla and 2nd by Alex.


Religious Education: Ellie Fry and Sara Weis are co-helping with the DRE responsibilities. This year we are offering Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) Level 1 and Level 2, and traditional classes for 4-8th grade. There are 21 kids for this year, 5 catechists, and 2 catechists aids. A Welcome letter, calendar, and registration forms were mailed out to registered parishioners. Several families may have not gotten them. (If you didn't get one please call the office 641-782-5278). There is shortage of Catechesis Good Shepherd catechists. Father suggested offering a training for CGS Level 1 at St. Edward. CGS helps the child reach their religious potential, but is also a great adult spiritual formation (www.cgsusa.org). Can we get 6 people to attend?

Unfinished Business: The board voted on 2020 roles; President - Dan McNeill, Vice President - Dennis Hopkins, Secretary—Shayla Findley. The council is in need of 2 additional council members. Members serve 3 year terms and meet every other month on the 3rd Sunday after Mass. (If you are interested in serving, please let a council member now.) Committee assignments will be reviewed in November. Dan has volunteered to help clean the church.

New Business: Council signed up to be money counters. (There still open months, if you would like to help please contact Sheila Brown.) Shayla gave updated from Dan on the bell tower. The vent in the bell tower might need to be replaced. St. Edward needs a new vacuums. The emergency plan was reviewed and signed. The council will plan to watch Slip/Trip Fall videos on their own time. There was discussion on the little library in the entrance of the church and council is wanting to remove it. Fr. Adam is working on RCIA program. The council discussed the sound system in basement, as the basement is a place for overflow during Sunday Mass.

Motion to adjourn by Sharon, 2nd by Alex. Next meeting will be Nov. 15.
