Monsignor's Musings



We celebrate the first Sunday of Advent with many themes presenting themselves for our reflection. Themes such as staying awake, being prepared, life, death, resurrection and the ongoing life Jesus gives us. This is the first day of December and the first day of Advent. We are called to fine tune all our senses to what is most important in life: Christ present among us in the kingdom of heaven. In the second reading Paul reminds us that our salvation is nearer at hand than when we first believed.

Advent calls us to reflect on both the gift of life and our mortality. We do not have unlimited time to spend our days without being a more intentional disciple. We're invited to put on the armor of light and become the Christ bearers we are called to be.

The prophet Isaiah reminds us of a time in the Temple in Jerusalem which not only belong to God's chosen people, the Jewish people, but to all the peoples of the world. For all nations shall stream

toward it in search of the divine wisdom which gives us guidance. The house of the Lord attracts all peoples of the world. This temple is a house of joy that promises unity, a place of peace and justice. What people and what nation doesn't long for this? We are called to journey joyfully to the feast of Christmas in the fullness of the kingdom of God. The responsorial psalm calls us to go rejoicing to the house the Lord. How can our parish become a place that brings joy to all peoples in our community during the Advent season?

The first and second readings today remind us of more imagery about the light that leads to the kingdom of God. We are reminded by St. Paul to throw off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light. We are called to walk in the light of the Lord. In the northern hemisphere the season of Advent coincides with the darkest time of the year. In celebrating the feast of Christmas we also celebrate the light of God coming into the world the mystery of the incarnation. We are called to confront the darkness inside ourselves and in the darkness in our world. And then to recommit ourselves to being the people of the light. - Bev Magr Douglas @ Beel


ADOPT A FAMILY, PAY IT FORWARD!


