SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

What is it about mountains? Why are we drawn to them? Why do we climb them so frequently? Is God really closer to us on the heights than daily in our hearts? It cannot be accidental that Jesus took his most trusted apostles to a mountain to be transfigured before them. Might there have been an intensification of expectation as they approached the summit? After all both Moses and Elijah met God on a mountain-the same mountain-Mount Sinai. Moses and Elijah went up a mountain and on its slopes met the living God. In each respective story neither Moses nor Elijah saw God, they only heard his voice. In our Gospel narrative these two biblical giants stand with Jesus and converse with him as he is revealed in all his heavenly glory.
