## INTERCESSION FOR LIFE

On this Feast of the Epiphany, may we be given the grace to always see in others the face of Christ our Savior; We pray to the Lord:

BE VIGILANT AT ALL TIMES AND PRAY THAT YOU MAY HAVE THE STRENGTH TO STAND BEFORE THE SON OF MAN" (LUKE 21:36).

## SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Wise men, magi, from the east arrive in Jerusalem, much to the shock of a Jewish king and the general population. Christians imagine the visitors to be three in number based on the three gifts brought to honor the newborn king, but this would hardly explain the "great troubling" of King Herod and his subjects.

The wise men travelled over 1,000 miles to arrive in Jerusalem. They read the heavens—which still declare the glory of God (Psalm 19:1)—to deduce from the planetary movements that something special had happened in Judea. They come to honor the birth of the newest king in Israel.

The gifts they offer are suitable for royalty. Gold is the common currency of the time period. Frankincense is an extremely valuable resin that is offered not only on Egyptian altars but also before the Lord in the Holy of Holies. Myrrh (in the form of an anointing oil) is sought after in Egypt as part of the extensive burial customs.

Each gift is received by Mary and Joseph. They could not have been aware that Herod would have designs on the life of their son. They could not have known that through the wise man God had just financed their future flight into Egypt where they will flee to avoid the wrath of the deadly king.

How are we like these wise men? How far out of our way are we willing to go to find the Lord? What hardships are we willing to endure to find the truth and the light? What treasures are we willing to offer our King? We Catholics should reflect on the Magi who were not even Jewish but sought the truth, nevertheless, which led them right up to the manger in Bethlehem.
