GOSPEL REFLECTION

"And they heard God speak from the cloud:
"This is my Son, . Listen to him."

Three of Jesus' most intimate disciples are brought to the mountain. Here Peter, James and John see Jesus revealed in his glorified body. "Listen to Him" the voice says. Remember the words Jesus has told you about this Messiah who is to be rejected, suffer and die shamefully. If the apostles could not understand and accept those sorrowful words, it was because they did not yet know the real Jesus. As Jesus will say later, "A grain of wheat remains no more than a single grain unless it is dropped into the ground and dies." The suffering and death of Jesus are the seeds of new life for all of us.

The transfiguration of Jesus that the disciples experienced was something done for their benefit—and—ultimately, *ours*.

It was an invitation to undergo personal transformation. How? By <u>listening to Jesus</u>, listening and obeying his teachings, however difficult.
