Gospel Reflection

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the 'hierarchy of the truths of faith'. (St. Augustine) The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men 'and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin'. (CCC 234)

The doctrine tells us that there is one God who is three distinct Persons. How can God be one and three at the same time? While our understanding of the Trinity has advanced and deepened over the centuries, this dogma of our faith <u>will always remain a mystery</u>. If we mere mortals try to solve this riddle <u>our heads will explode—so just accept!</u>

C.S. Lewis expressed the thought that even though the Trinity is something that is ultimately beyond us, *"Trinity-life"* is there for us to experience: God (the Father) is the one we pray to, God (the Holy Spirit) is also the thing inside us urging us to pray, and God (the Son) is the road along which we are led to that goal.


