

Gospel Reflection

"Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." (John 6:56)

Was Jesus speaking in symbols and metaphors? Those who were listening to Jesus knew he was NOT. Indeed the Bible says many off his followers left him and the rest started arguing about what he had just said, "The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us (his) flesh to eat?" (John 6:52) It was clear to them that Jesus was talking about his flesh as bread.

Why is there no room for confusion? When we read what Jesus said in the original language of the Gospel, Greek, we see that what Jesus said was very clear.....and shocking. In the original language Jesus didn't just say "eat my flesh" but something much stronger like "chew on my flesh" Or "gnaw on my flesh" Or "crunch my flesh with your teeth." So in the original language the last line reads something like this, 'your ancestors ate the bread that came down from heaven and died but whoever gnaws and crunches on this bread will live forever.'!!!!

SO READING THE GOSPEL IN ITS ORIGINAL LANGUAGE LEAVES NO ROOM FOR CONFUSION. The Eucharist IS his actual flesh and the wine IS his actual blood...

Can't understand it?.... Can you accept without proof? Can you add faith to your reason and logic? Come to Jesus—not like a scientist, analyzing—but as a child, trusting. Receive Almighty God's greatest gift.
