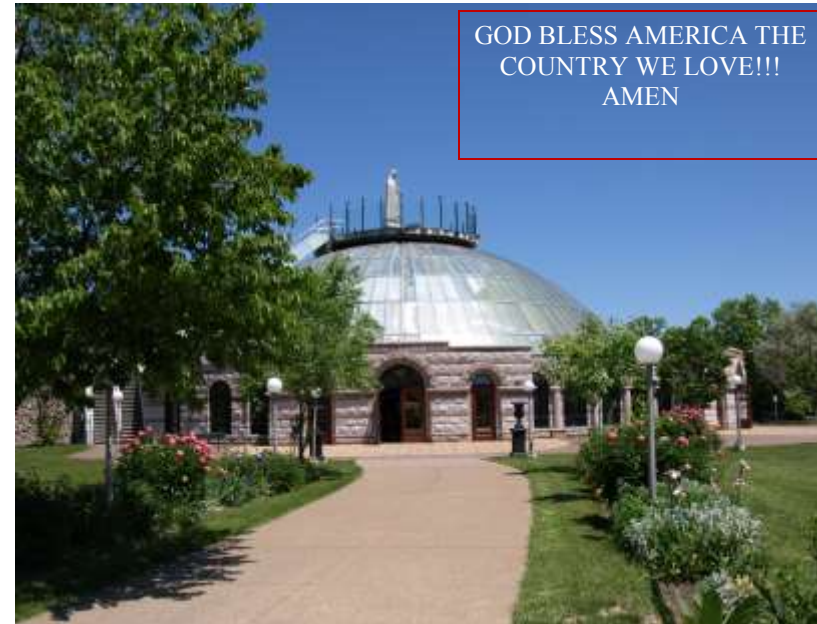

Gospel Reflection

The reason why the people of Nazareth reject Jesus in Mark 6:1-6 seems kind of nutty at first reading. The people of Capernaum had accepted the teaching of Jesus, but the people in his own hometown, Nazareth, were so scandalized they **tried to throw him off a cliff!!**

Did they think Jesus was crazy? Earlier in Mark 3:21, Jesus' **own family** had come to get him because they thought he had "gone out of his mind." Did they think, like the scribes in Mark 3:22, that he got his power from the Devil? Or was it a status thing—could they simply not get over the fact that it was Jesus—just a 'carpenter'?

Sadly, these people chose to reject the grace and forgiveness of the Christ. They couldn't get past their prejudices and pre-conceived notions of what the Messiah should look and act like. Their hard hearts were **positive** it wasn't Jesus—their kinsman! "Leave us alone, our lives are okay without you!" they cried.

And so their lack of faith prevented him from doing any "mighty deeds". He certainly could have forced them into submission by overawing them with some fantastic miracle but He aside his strength to give the people of Nazareth time to repent and open their hearts. It is an act of sublime meekness and a sign of His grace and His patience. Our brother does not force Himself upon us—**then or now**—but reveals himself and waits for us to open the door of our heart and receive him as our Blessed Lord.
