#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

In today's very short Gospel, Jesus shows utmost kindness in two separate accounts. First, He offers his disciples rest after what must have been a grueling journey of evangelization for them all. "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest awhile". Jesus knows they are wiped out.

After their plans for rest are ruined by the huge crowds, Jesus doesn't tell the crowds to go away and 'come back to-morrow...today's our day off". Rather, "his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and He began to teach them many things".

The lesson here is two-fold. First, if Jesus was concerned about the disciples' need for rest and refreshment—then He is concerned with OUR need for the same things—especially in this diabolically busy world. WE need rest. WE need quiet. We need to have refreshing drink and delicious food and unwind with our friends. We need these things in order to live a balanced life and fulfill our obligations without losing our peace (and our mind.....).

At the same time, even though our need for rest and refreshment is legitimate, sometimes we are interrupted by inconvenient people at inconvenient times. What then?

Then—we bite the bullet and respond the way Jesus just taught us—with grace and patience.
