#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

A careful reading of the text indicates that, while Jesus did recognize the possibility of divorce, he distinguished it from *divorce and remar-*<u>riage</u>. He may have had to accept the hardness of people's hearts and concede that in cases of physical danger or emotional violence divorce might be the only answer.

However, if a man divorced <u>and remarried</u>, Jesus maintained that he would be committing adultery against the one to whom he had been joined in one flesh—his former wife.

His injunction ran totally against the culture of the day. In the 'honor' system of the society, the man would not have committed adultery against the woman but against her <u>father or brothers</u>. Women did not rate in the 'honor' hierarchy. It was the honor of the family, specifically the males, which was insulted. It was a radical thing to say that a divorced man who remarried sinned against his <u>wife</u> not her family!

Jesus challenged this cultural stereotype and the issue of the dignity of women and their place in society. He radically rejected both the 'honor' system as well as the view held that women were merely property with no rights.

At the same time he admonished women that if *they* divorced and remarried they would be held to the same standard as men.
