SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

A king is hosting a wedding banquet for his son. He sends out his servants to announce to the invited quests that all is prepared and the feast is ready to begin. The shock of the parable is revealed in the response of those high-society invitees. They had already accepted the invitation before finding out they were to eat with the lowly. The king has counted their RSVPs and slaughtered the required number of animals to feed his quests but now these quests ignore the summons and fail to honor their commitment. Biblical-era meals were shared affairs. Everyone at the table ate from common dishes. Elites would eat with elites, common folk with common folk, sinners with other sinners. To reach out and share from a common plate could result in ritual defilement and the need for a purification rite to re-establish yourself as an honorable member of the community. That was too big a risk to take in the honor/ shame culture of the New Testament period.

Jesus is willing to break through these social barriers. St. Paul too. He understood this when he writes to the Galatians that in Christ (and in the church) there is no distinction made between a Jew and a Greek, a slave or a free man, or even between a woman and a man. We are all one in Christ and are all welcome at the table of the Lord.

If the properly invited quests refuse to attend the greatest banquet of a lifetime, the king will make sure that the food does not go to waste. The hall will be opened to those who will respond to the invitation even if they have to be "compelled" to attend. The king will win in the end. Those who were *in* are now *out* and those on the *outside* now find themselves in the kinadom!
