## SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Jesus's parables are unique because of shock elements that surprise his audience and leave them in doubt as to each story's meaning. In the parable of the talents, the surprise turn is that the rich are going to get richer and the poor will have what little they hold taken from them. This is hardly fair! It's not the conclusion the listeners expected. To unpack its meaning, we have to look at the emphasis at the story's conclusion.

Jesus uses this parable to teach his disciples that we should not play it safe and expect everything to work out when end-time realities are on the line. The stakes are raised as we anticipate the final judgment and we need to be willing to do all we can to know that we will be with the Lord when the end comes. Everything is on the line now and the old way of following expected norms may not be enough. It is a time to be creative, energized, taking full advantage of every opportunity to draw closer to God.

Today we are closer to that time than yesterday and tomorrow we will be even closer still. Two servants are clever and engaged. They act to secure their position of favor with their master. The third does not. He falls back on what has always worked in the past. It won't work this time, and what he has is taken from him and given to the one who has even more. When the end approaches—and it will for all of us—it is worth risking all for the assurance of entering into the joy of our Master.
