#### SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

The scene opens with the appearance of the "Son of Man" who comes in glory with his angels and then sits on a throne from which he will judge all the nations. These assembled peoples will be separated like a shepherd separates sheep from goats. The sheep on the right—the goats on the left. This separation in a flock was a common scene that everyone in the time of Jesus could relate to

Sheep were the preferred animal of sacrifice. They were considered honorable animals because they did not bleat or cry out during the sacrifice and, among other things, the rams would protect the ewes in the herd. Goats, on the other hand, were loud and destructive and the males did not protect their females. Every day just before sunset the shepherd would gather the white sheep and pen them in for the night while the black goats were sent off to fend for themselves. It is an evocative image.

The shocking aspect of the parable is the <u>criteria</u> for judgment. *Deeds* are going to trump *creeds*. Those judged righteous will find themselves on the right side of the King because they acted mercifully toward the hungry, the thirsty, the naked, the sick, and visited people in prison. The rejected ones will be judged for their failures on the same criteria.

All those judged will be surprised. "When did we see you ...?" will be the question both groups ask the Son of Man. All the assembled had the same opportunity to help others but some did and some did not. How did everyone treat "the least of these brothers of mine....?"

We have a duty to serve, and God provides people around us to give us opportunities to fulfill that command. As it turns out, what we do for those in need is the very thing this scene of the final judgment will be based upon. What do you and I do to serve those in need?


