

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Fiat voluntas tua — "Thy will be done." When Mary gave her full and knowing consent to the angel of the Lord, she provided the supreme example of human cooperation to the Divine Will. She placed all her trust in the Lord, willingly and without reservation, even though she knew full well an unwed teen mother in those days meant disgrace and possible execution. We live in more tolerant times, and sometimes we miss that part of the fiat and what Mary risked in offering it. Mary doesn't just assent to the pregnancy, but to laying down her life for the Lord — both literally and figuratively. She commits her all in surrendering to His will.

We too have the same free will. That is our gift from God. As C. S. Lewis wrote in *The Screwtape Letters*, God does not want slaves to do His bidding under His command, but sons and daughters who willingly and joyfully join in His work. When we have conflict between our designs and those of the Lord's, do we accept the change willingly? Or do we accept grudgingly, angrily, or perhaps refuse to accept it at all?

Mary had plans for her life, too, before the Annunciation. She was betrothed, and probably looked forward to a normal life raising a family and perhaps finding some ease of life. She put all of that aside in a moment when the Lord made His will known to her. She put her trust in Him—no questions asked.

So what will we say when <u>our</u> day comes? Will we have formed ourselves enough to say, *Fiat voluntas tua*?

God has something in mind for us to do and He waits for our response. If we say 'Yes!' the work of God in our world will be brought forward. Like Mary we dare to say, 'Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be done to me according to your word.'
