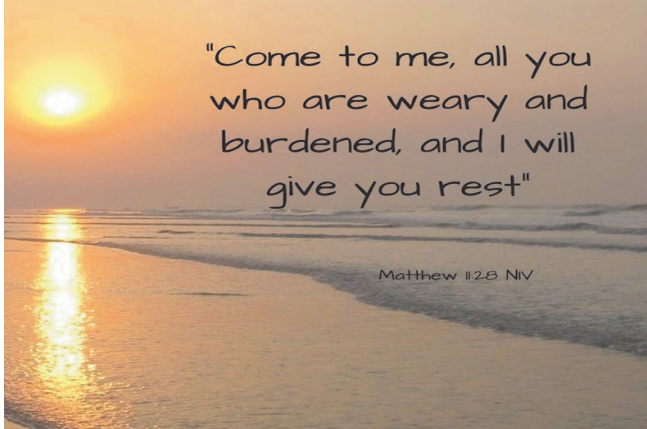

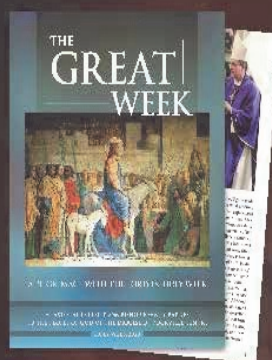
BISHOP BARRES WRITES PASTORAL LETTER ON HOLY WEEK

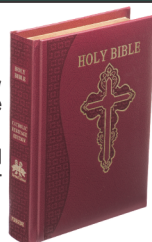
