



As we continue to navigate through this challenging time, we are pleased to be able to say that things are beginning to open up here at the parish, although in a limited way. We are happy to communicate the following:

WEEKEND MASSES ARE CELEBRATED AT 5PM ON SATURDAYS

AND 10AM ON SUNDAYS. You must register to attend these Masses weekly through our parish website beginning each Wednesday morning at 9am. The program will stop accepting reservations on Friday at 3pm (or sooner if it reaches a maximum of 80 people for that particular Mass).\*\* PLEASE NOTE NEW REGISTRATION DAYS AND TIMES! Ushers will check your registrations at the door before entering the church and will seat you. The pews in the church are marked off to maintain social distancing.

## BOTH WEEKEND MASSES WILL NOW BE LIVE STREAMED ON YOUTUBE AT 5PM AND 10AM —LINK AVAILABLE FROM OUR

WEBSITE. If you click on the Mass and it has already begun, you will have the ability on *YouTube* to rewind the Mass to the beginning while it is in progress. Don't worry if you are unable to rewind — the Mass in its entirety will also be available immediately after its conclusion. Live streaming will allow you to attend Mass at home simultaneously with your fellow parishioners in the church, and with much clearer video and sound than we have been able to offer in the past.

THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION IS OFFERED ON SATURDAYS AT 4PM IN THE CHURCH. Unfortunately due to limited seating, you cannot remain for the 5pm Mass after Reconciliation if you have not reserved a seat ahead of time.

#### Dear Parishioners,

We have been given direction from the Diocese of Rockville Centre to reopen for the public celebration of Mass within State Guidelines. Therefore, St. Sylvester Parish will be having Mass on Saturdays at 5:00PM and Sundays at 10:00AM.

Please note the following important information:

- At this time, the bishop still dispenses all the faithful from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation.
- Our Sunday worship will continue to be posted on the website for those who are vulnerable, for those who have a health impairment that would make them more susceptible to serious illness, for those who might not be feeling well, or have a fever, and for those who are caretakers for other people who are vulnerable. If you are in any of these situations, you are encouraged to continue to remain at home and worship online.
- \* One bathroom will be open for emergency use only! Please use restroom at home!
- There is a mandatory online reservation system for all who wish to attend Mass. Please register beginning Wednesdays at 9am by going to www.stsylvesterli.org
- Please print out your registration information or have available on your phone as you will be asked to show your registration before entering the church.
- Masks or other face coverings must be worn by all participants.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before Mass so your reservation may be confirmed and you may be shown to your seat. Capacity at this time is limited to 25%.
- Seating will be done according to social distancing guidelines. Please understand that you most likely will not be sitting in your "usual" seat. Families may sit together at Mass. There is no "saving seats" or asking to be seated in a particular seat.
- The Offertory procession and passing of the donation basket will be omitted.
- If you wish to make a contribution, there will be a basket on your way out.
- The Sign of Peace or other greetings will not be exchanged.
- Directions will be given for Communion, which will be distributed after Mass as you are leaving the church. Please follow the directions of the ushers.
- No bulletins will be distributed. Please read the bulletin online.
- Please go directly to your car, as no congregating is permitted.
- We will continue to keep you updated on changes as we move forward.

This is a work in progress, so as we move forward there may be changes. We appreciate your patience and want you to know that our first priority is that those attending Mass

## What Will Faith Formation 2020-2021 Look Like?

After much conversation, prayer and discernment we have decided to keep all Faith Formation class Schedules/Calendars the same as they were in the past year, BUT to conduct all classes through the Zoom platform, virtually. Arrangements will be made for a curbside pickup of the materials (books, calendar, etc.) needed for each of your children so they can work from home. So think of it this way, Faith Formation will be the same as it was last year, except classes will not be held at the parish. Instead, your child's class for which you have registered them will be held on the Zoom platform from your home. For example, and to be clear, if you registered your child for a Level 5 class on Mondays at 4:30 p.m., your child's class will be held virtually on Mondays at 4:30 p.m. each week according to the Level 5 Calendar. The same will hold true for all Levels, 1 through 8 and Home Taught. We will send you a link that you will simply click on to join the class. You will need a computer or device that has a camera, microphone and speaker. We will have a test run before classes begin so that parents and students can become familiar with the process.



#### Get Out of the Boat!

The Gospel begins with the disciples getting into a boat to arrive on the other side ahead of Jesus, who we learn dismissed the crowds and went to pray alone. The boat departs and is already a few miles offshore when we are told it is getting tossed around by the waves.

I reflected on this as I sat at my home computer in the middle of our own near hurricane, Isaias, which I read, ironically means "God is my salvation". As wind gusts hurled tree branches and pieces of fencing past my rain-soaked windows like so many matchsticks, I imagined the disciples sitting in a boat in rough seas and spotting a figure walking toward them on the inky, black water with the wind howling. They were understandably terrified, thinking they were seeing a ghost until Jesus called out to them, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." I know I would be scared out of my wits! Peter, still apprehensive, challenges Christ, saying, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." Jesus calls Peter forward and he begins to walk on the water toward Jesus, his instinctive faith carrying him across the waves. However, once he thinks about what he is doing, Peter lets his fear take hold of him and begins to sink, causing Jesus to have to rescue him.

How many times do we, as faithful stewards, hear God calling us to action, but over-analyze the situation and dismiss that voice within us? It is human nature to initially be afraid to act, to change — to develop and use our gifts in the way God wishes. It takes trust and commitment. Stepping out of the boat onto the water can be scary, but Jesus will always be there with his hand outstretched to us if we falter.




