Pastor's Column SS Medford 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time Of Goats and Sheep

August 4, 2019

I was away with other priests this past weekend. Once a year, I am blessed to spend a week or ten days with other priests who are members of an international priestly fraternity.

We stayed at a conference center in Delray Beach, Florida named Roseaire. There we could relax, pray together, enjoy good fraternity and excurse into areas unknown or unseen.

The street which led to our "home" is called Brady Drive. One of the participants who accompanied me is from Boston. He proudly proclaimed that the street, since it had the surname of Tom Brady, the Patriots six-time champion quarterback, should be renamed. Father Dave proposed G.O.A.T. Drive—the Greatest of All Time Drive!

Funny how we can idolize sporting women and men. This moniker has come up recently with the Women's World Cup team, much more palatable as they are the greatest, with an unmatched record. Unfortunately, they are paid less than the men, for some wrong reason.

I digress. Mariano Rivera, also considered a "GOAT," was inducted into the Hall of Fame for Major League Baseball. His first words of acceptance were (approximately), "I first have to thank the Lord, my Lord, Jesus Christ, who has bestowed on me so many blessings, most especially faith in salvation." W.O.W.!

Mo is not the greatest of all time. Jesus is! How humble. True? Yes, for me and you and I hope (in the most grounded, virtuous way) that this is what we are teaching our children and grandchildren.

Oddly enough, Jesus does not think much of goats. He uses them as an analogy for the damned. The sheep are righteous, for they seek their shepherd to guide them. Goats are more independent and will revert to wilding at the first possibility. They will follow the shepherd when the pastures are ripe. Once times become delicate and green meadows fade away, they bolt away, never to be seen again.

Our Gospel today points out that we should focus on heaven and not earthly things. Unity of Life is a term that means that we should do everything governed by our faith—our politeness, our willingness to forgive (last week's Gospel) and our striving to become perfectly pleasant. We bring all of these things to our everyday: work, school, vacation, or whatever we do in this time of our life. In this way, we are sheep who follow the Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ. Let us become saints, what else is there!

Assumption of Our Lady Holy Day of Obligation ~Thursday, August 15th

In preparation for the feast of the Assumption of Our Lady, which commemorates the end of her earthly life and assumption into heaven, Fr. Suglia would like to have a novena said. Beginning Tuesday, August 6th and going nine consecutive days ending Wednesday, August 14th, a novena will be said before morning Mass in the Worship Room of the Parish Center, beginning at 8:15AM. A novena can be said both *publicly and privately*. On Wednesday



during the week when morning Mass is not held, the Worship Room will be opened for those who would like to say the novena together. The Worship Room will not be opened on Saturday morning, August 10th, and Sunday morning, August 11th, so you may wish to say the novena privately those days.

On Tuesday, August 13th, in the spirit of community, there will be hospitality after the morning Mass in the East Wing of the Parish Center.

What is a Novena?

A novena is a vocal prayer, or series of vocal prayers, that you commit to praying over an extended period of time. Most novenas are directed to God through a particular saint (e.g. the St. Joseph Novena), so you are asking for the saint's prayers each day for a specific intention. Some novenas are longer (e.g. the 30-day St. Joseph Novena or the 54-day Rosary novena), but traditionally they are nine days. These prayers are usually linked to a specific devotion (for instance, a devotion to a particular saint) or liturgical celebration (a novena for Pentecost). When we use

this kind of prayer, we align our minds and hearts with the meaning of the words, giving God praise, renewing our faith and trust, asking God for things we need or desire, or all of the above.

The first novena was inspired by Christ Himself who, at the time of His Ascension into Heaven, told the Apostles to prepare for the coming of the Holy Spirit (at Pentecost); the Apostles went to Jerusalem and prayed with our Blessed Mother for nine days, awaiting the gift of the Spirit (Acts 1). The Holy Spirit then descended upon Mary and the Apostles in the Upper Room. The Novena to the Holy Spirit is the first novena.






